S.B. No. 296

AN ACT

relating to sunset review of the Texas Conservation Foundation.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas:

SECTION 1. Section 181.020, Natural Resources Code, is amended to read as follows: Sec. 181.020. APPLICATION OF SUNSET ACT. The Texas Conservation Foundation is subject to the Texas Sunset Act (Chapter 325, Government Code) [(Article 5429k, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes)]. Unless continued in existence as provided by that Act, the foundation is abolished and this chapter expires September 1, 1991 [1987].

SECTION 2. The importance of this legislation and the crowded condition of the calendars in both houses create an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days in each house be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended, and that this Act take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and it is so enacted.

Passed the Senate on April 2, 1987, by the following vote: Yeas 25, Nays 0; and that the Senate concurred in House amendment on June 1, 1987, by a viva-voce vote. Passed the House, with amendment, on May 30, 1987, by a non-record vote.

Approved June 19, 1987.
