S.B. No. 483

AN ACT

relating to the authority of a home-rule city to provide publicly owned facilities for human services to the indigent.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas:

SECTION 1. Article 1175, Revised Statutes, as amended, is amended by adding Subdivision 37 to read as follows:

37. A home-rule city may provide publicly owned facilities for use by organizations that provide human services to the indigent. In this subdivision, "human services" includes the provision of housing, food, clothing, and day care services.

SECTION 2. The importance of this legislation and the crowded condition of the calendars in both houses create an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days in each house be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended, and that this Act take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and it is so enacted.

Passed the Senate on March 26, 1987, by the following vote: Yeas 30, Nays 0. Passed the House on April 30, 1987, by the following vote: Yeas 133, Nays 0, one present not voting.
