## **CHAPTER 257**

S.B. No. 652

AN ACT

relating to the execution of a waiver of interest in a child.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas:

SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 15.041, Family Code, is amended to read as follows:

(a) An [A person may execute an] affidavit disclaiming any interest in a child and waiving notice or the service of citation in any suit filed or to be filed affecting the parent-child relationship with respect to the child may be executed for the purposes of this section by any person except the child's mother.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 1987.

SECTION 3. The importance of this legislation and the crowded condition of the calendars in both houses create an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days in each house be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended.
