CHAPTER 319

S.B. No. 756

AN ACT

relating to the organization and administration of the Real Estate Research Center at Texas A&M University.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas:

SECTION 1. Section 86.51, Education Code, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 86.51. REAL ESTATE RESEARCH CENTER. There is established at Texas A&M University [in the College of Agriculture,] a Real Estate Research Center, hereinafter referred to as the center. The operating budget, staffing, and activities of the center shall be approved by the board of regents [directors] of The Texas A&M University System.

SECTION 2. The importance of this legislation and the crowded condition of the calendars in both houses create an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the 1718

constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days in each house be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended, and that this Act take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and it is so enacted.

Passed the Senate on April 30, 1987, by the following vote: Yeas 31, Nays 0. Passed the House on May 22, 1987, by the following vote: Yeas 148, Nays 0, one present not voting.
