CHAPTER 215

S.B. No. 791

AN ACT

relating to student center fees at Lamar University.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Texas:

SECTION 1. Section 108.37, Education Code, as amended, is amended to read as follows:

Sec. 108.37. STUDENT CENTER FEES. The board of regents may levy a regular fixed student fee not to exceed \$30 [\$20] per student for each semester of the long session and not to exceed \$15 [\$10] per student for each term of the summer session, against each student enrolled in the institution, as in their discretion may be just and necessary for the purpose of operating, maintaining, improving, and equipping the student center and acquiring or constructing additions to the student center.

SECTION 2. The importance of this legislation and the crowded condition of the calendars in both houses create an emergency and an imperative public necessity that the constitutional rule requiring bills to be read on three several days in each house be suspended, and this rule is hereby suspended, and that this Act take effect and be in force from and after its passage, and it is so enacted.

Passed the Senate on April 15, 1987, by the following vote: Yeas 31, Nays 0. Passed the House on May 15, 1987, by the following vote: Yeas 144, Nays 0, one present not voting.
