County Clerk office is seeking civic minded citizens who would like to get involved in the Election process. Running successful elections always requires the ongoing support of the community and its citizens. Please help by becoming a <u>Poll Worker</u>.

What does a poll worker do?

- •The worker will work at the polls on Early Voting or Election Day throughout Nueces County.
- •Set up the polling place and open the poll.
- •Greet and assist voters.
- •Qualify voter and do election paperwork at polling site.
- •Issue the voter an access code to enable them to vote an electronic ballot.
- •Close polling place and disassemble the appropriate equipment.

What is the service time?

•Early Voting:

Typically eight (8) hours per day for 14 days.

•Election Day:

Typically through the full Election Day period from 6: 30 AM to 7:30 PM

What is the pay?

- •Early Voting Clerk (poll worker) is paid at \$8.00 an hour and called to duty by Nueces County Clerk.
- •Election Day Judge & Alternate Judge are paid at \$8.00 an hour but appointed by the political party. Judges will then select their own Election Day Clerks for their own location and are paid at \$8.00 an hour also. Nueces County Clerk's office provides names of interested clerks to election judges.
- •Training class is paid at \$8.00 an hour.

What are the requirements?

- •Must be at least 18 years of age
- •Must be a registered voter
- •Must **not** hold an elected office **OR not** be an employee of an elected official **if** the elected official is a candidate who is opposed in the current election
- Must be able to read and write

EXCEPTION: If the elected official is uncontested in the election then there are no restrictions on the applicant.
