

**ORDER AUTHORIZING THE LEGAL SALE OF
ALL ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES FOR OFF-PREMISE CONSUMPTION ONLY**

Whereas, the Commissioners Court of Lubbock County, Texas finds that on the 9th day of May, 2009, an election was conducted to legalize the legal sale of all alcoholic beverages for off-premise consumption only;

Whereas, on the 18th day of May, 2009, the Commissioners Court of Lubbock County, Texas canvassed the vote for the May 9, 2009 Local Election;

Whereas, the Commissioners Court of Lubbock County, Texas hereby DECLARES that the aforementioned issue has been approved by the voters of Lubbock County, Texas;

NOW THEREFORE IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND DECREED, that the legal sale of all alcoholic beverages for off-premise consumption only is legal within Lubbock County, Texas.


It is further ORDERED that not later than the third day after the date of this Order, the county clerk shall certify the result to the Secretary of State and to the Texas Alcoholic Beverage Commission. The clerk may not charge a fee for this service.

This Order shall be published by posting certified copies at three public places in the county.






Bill McCay, Precinct 1



Gilbert A. Flores, Precinct 3




Mark Heinrich, Precinct 2




