## MDR Tracking Number: M4-05-1876-01

Under the provisions of Section 413.031 of the Texas Workers' Compensation Act, Title 5, Subtitle A of the Texas Labor Code, effective June 17, 2001 and Commission Rule 133.305, titled <u>Medical Dispute Resolution-General</u>, and 133.307, titled <u>Medical Dispute Resolution of a Medical Fee Dispute</u>, a review was conducted by the Division regarding a medical fee dispute between the requestor and the respondent named above. This dispute was received on 9/22/03.

### I. DISPUTE

Whether there should be additional reimbursement for 1/27/03 through 4/01/03. The Carrier denied reimbursement as "F – Submitted documentation does not support or meet the criteria for one-on-one therapy that is identified in the fee guidelines ground rules and/or CPT code descriptor for reimbursement. F – Reimbursement according to the Texas Medical Fee Guidelines. F – If reduction, then processed according to the Texas Fee Guidelines."

# II. RATIONALE

### Dates of Service 1/27/03 through 4/01/03; CPT code 97110 Therapeutic Exercises

Recent review of disputes involving CPT Code 97110 by the Medical Dispute Resolution section indicate overall deficiencies in the adequacy of the documentation of this Code both with respect to the medical necessity of one-on-one therapy and documentation reflecting that these individual services were provided as billed. Moreover, the disputes indicate confusion regarding what constitutes "one-on-one." Therefore, consistent with the general obligation set forth in Section 413.016 of the Labor Code, the Medical Review Division has reviewed the matters in light all of the Commission requirements for proper documentation. The MRD declines to order payment because the SOAP notes do not clearly delineate exclusive one-on-one therapy. Additional reimbursement not recommended.

# **III. DECISION**

Based upon the review of the disputed healthcare services within this request, the Division has determined that the Requestor is not entitled to reimbursement for CPT code 97110.
