PART V: REVIEW OF SUMMARY, METHODOLOGY AND EXPLANATION

Section §413.011(a-d) titled, *Reimbursement Policies and Guidelines*, and Division Rule 134.202 titled, *Medical Fee Guideline* effective August 1, 2003, sets out the reimbursement guidelines.

The Requestor withdrew CPT Codes 36000 and 99499 listed on the Table of Disputed Services; therefore, these CPT codes will not be a part of this review.

1. These services were denied by the Respondent with reason code "97 – Payment is included in the allowance for another service/procedure, 217 – The value of this procedure is included in the value of another procedure performed on this date" and "W4 – No additional reimbursement allowed after review of appeal/reconsideration, 435 – Per NCCI edits, the value of this procedure is included in the value of the comprehensive procedure, 891 – The insurance company is reducing or denying payment after reconsidering a bill."

2. Per Rule 134.202(b), CPT code 72275 is considered to be a component procedure of CPT codes 62311; however, a modifier is allowed to differentiate between the services provided. The Requestor's CMS-1500 supports that this code was billed with a modifier -59; therefore, per Rule 134.202(c)(1) reimbursement is recommended.
