STRATEGY DESCRIPTION AND JUSTIFICATION:

The Consolidated Waiver Program (CWP) is a pilot 1915(c) Medicaid waiver authorized by House Bill 2148, 76th Legislative Session. The purpose of this pilot is to test the feasibility of consolidating five of the state's eight 1915(c) Medicaid waivers. The CWP consolidates Community Based Alternatives (CBA), Medically Dependent Children Program (MDCP), Community Living Assistance and Support Services (CLASS), Home and Community-based Services (HCS) and Deaf Blind Multiple Disabilities (DBMD) waivers. The pilot is limited to Bexar County, and serves 192 individuals. CWP is targeted to serve 96 individuals who qualify for nursing facility care (48 adults and 48 children) and 96 individuals who qualify for ICF-MR care (48 adults and 48 children, with both groups evenly divided between individuals with mental retardation and individuals with developmental disabilities).

Statutory Authority: Social Security Act, §1915(c)(7)(B).

EXTERNAL/INTERNAL FACTORS IMPACTING STRATEGY:

In the base request, rates for CWP have been reduced by 1.06% due to funding restraints associated with 5% reductions and the biennial decrease in the FMAP. Exceptional Items Number 2 and 3 seek to restore these reductions.

Demand for this program is projected to increase during the FY 2006-2007 biennium, increasing the number of individuals waiting for services.
