

ORDINANCE NO. 2539

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORSICANA, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 11, ARTICLE 11.200 SECTIONS 11.207 AND 11.208 OF THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES REGULATING PLACEMENT OF GARBAGE CONTAINERS FOR COLLECTION PURPOSES AND PRESCRIBING TIMES FOR PLACEMENT AND REMOVAL.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Corsicana, Texas, that Chapter 11, Article 11.2.100, Section 11.207 (a) of the City Code of Ordinances be amended to hereafter read as follows:

Chapter 11: Utilities and Solid Waste

Article 11.200 Solid Waste Code

Sec. 11.207 Garbage Containers – Placement for Collection Purposes, Residences

(a) Garbage. It shall be the duty of the head of every family occupying or in possession of any house, building, flat, apartment, tenement or dwelling place in the City of Corsicana, which is a private residence, and for which a container for garbage has been provided, to place, or cause to be placed, such container on the rear of the lot of said premises where pick-ups are made from alleys in the rear of such premises. It shall be unlawful for any person to place any such container in any alley within the City, and in all cases where garbage is to be collected from the alley, the container shall be placed entirely within the lot line adjacent to, but not in, the alley. Where there is no alley, and where garbage is collected from the street in front of such premises, such garbage can, brush and rubbish shall be placed inside the curb line on the street, or at such other place as may be designated by the City Manager, or his designated representative, to be collected by the garbage vehicles.

No garbage, rubbish or trash shall be placed on the curb for collection earlier than 5:00 p.m. the day before the regular scheduled day of collection, but must be at the curb by 6:30 a.m. on the day of collection. Solid waste containing putrescible animal and vegetable waste must be in water-tight animal proof receptacles. All solid waste receptacles must be removed from the curb by 10:00 p.m. on collection day.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Corsicana, Texas, that Chapter 11, Article 11.200, Section 11.208 be amended to hereafter read as follows:


Sec. 11.208 Garbage Containers – Placement for Collection Purposes, Businesses

(a) Historic Main Street District. Any business establishment in the *Historic Main Street District*, as defined by the City of Corsicana, desiring to place garbage, rubbish or trash for collection shall set container(s) in front of the business for hand-collection unless dumpster service is available.

- 1) Boxes and cartons shall be broken down and bundled and placed on the curb. No bundle shall exceed thirty-five (35) pounds in weight.

- 2) Solid waste containing putrescible animal and vegetable waste must be in water-tight, animal-proof receptacles. All other waste must be bagged or contained as necessary to prevent wind blowing or spillage.
 - 3) No garbage, rubbish or trash shall be placed at the curb for collection earlier than 5:00 p.m. the day before the regular scheduled day of collection but must be at the curb by 5:00 a.m. on the day of collection.
 - 4) Immediately after the garbage, rubbish or trash has been removed by the collector, container(s) shall be removed to a place within or behind the business establishment.
- b) All Other Businesses. Any business establishment desiring to place garbage, rubbish or trash for collection shall set container(s) on the lot as directed by the City of Corsicana.
- 1) Boxes and cartons shall be broken down and bundled and placed on the curb. No bundle shall exceed thirty-five (35) pounds in weight.
 - 2) Solid waste containing putrescible animal and vegetable waste must be in water-tight, animal-proof receptacles. All other waste must be bagged or contained as necessary to prevent wind blowing or spillage.
 - 3) No garbage, rubbish or trash shall be placed at the curb for collection earlier than 5:00 p.m. the day before the regular scheduled day of collection but must be at the curb by 5:00 a.m. on the day of collection.
 - 4) Immediately after the garbage, rubbish or trash has been removed by the collector, container(s) shall be removed to a place within or behind the business establishment.


