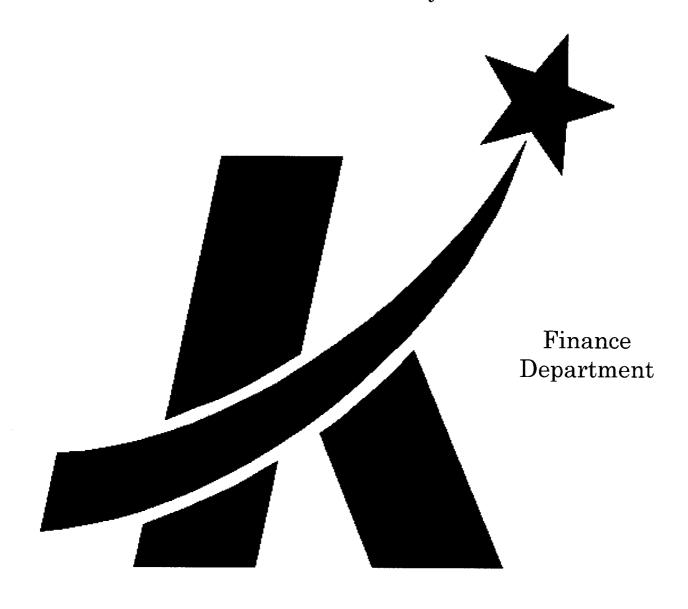

FINANCE DIRECTOR'S REPORT MAY 2009

June 26, 2009

Mayor and City Council Members:

We are pleased to submit the Monthly City Council Financial Report and Executive Summary for the month of May 2009. Finance staff is working with the departments and the City Manager on the 2009-10 budget submission. The City Manager's Preliminary Budget should be ready for Council distribution in July. In addition to the budget preparation, finance staff completed a mid-year budget review and mid-year budget amendment which was approved by City Council on June 23, 2009.

General Fund ad valorem revenues are meeting budget and staff projections, with 97.44% of the annual ad valorem assessment collected by May 31st. Total operating expenses for all major funds are on target with staff estimates with no significant variances noted. The Finance Department will work closely with the departments to monitor their revenues and expenses during FY 2008-09.

Key economic indicators of the local economy reflect the recession that our country is currently facing. One of the seven economic indicators monitored in this monthly report is positive with Unemployment Rate, Sales Tax Revenue, Aviation Enplanement and Deplanements, Building Permits, Water and Sewer Tap Fees, and Hotel Occupancy Tax Revenues being negative. These indicators are discussed in detail in the attached Economic Indicators Summary Report.

CITY OF KILLEEN FINANCIAL REPORT- MAY 2009 EXECUTIVE SUMMARY MAJOR OPERATING FUNDS

GENERAL FUND

- Revenues total \$3,353,252 for the month, down from last year's revenues of \$3,714,261 by 9.7%. Year-to-date general fund revenues of \$44,746,017 are up 4.3% over last year's total of \$42,900,817.
- Sales Tax Collections for the month were \$1,812,418, a decrease of 7.2% from last May's collections of \$1,953,800. Year-to-date sales tax collections of \$12,041,847 are below last year's total of \$13,146,336 by 8.4%.
- ➤ Property Tax Collections during the month were \$122,419, an 11.0% increase above last year's collections of \$110,318. Year-to-date property tax receipts of \$20,858,414 exceed last years total of \$17,666,347 by 18.1%. Year-to-date collections are at 97.4% of the budget.
- Franchise Fees collected during May were \$168,824 compared to \$189,154 last May. Year-to-date franchise revenues of \$1,467,039 are above last year's total of \$1,438,363 by 2.0%.
- Permits & Inspections fees collected during May totaled \$109,842, down 23.2% from last year's revenue of \$142,950. Year-to-date revenues of \$662,116 are 29.2% below last year's total of \$935,599. The variance is largely attributable to Building Permits and Inspections coming in at a lower rate than the prior year.
- Court fines and fees were \$167,914 during May, up 8.2% above the prior year collections of \$155,235. Year-to-date revenues total \$1,465,294, 8.0% above last year's total of \$1,356,788.
- Interest Earned during May totaled \$15,451, a decrease of 77.5% below last May's interest earnings of \$68,769. Year-to-date interest earnings total \$291,479, 65.2% below last year's total of \$836,602. Year-to-date earnings are at 18.2% of the budget.
- Total expenditures for May are \$4,657,504, 5.3% above \$4,424,108 last year. Year-to-date expenditures of \$40,348,880 are up 4.0% when compared to last year's expenditures of \$38,791,415. This variance is largely attributable to the new Lions Club Park facilities operations costs plus Police and Fire Department expenditures related to additional positions being filled this fiscal year.
- > The ending fund balance for the month was \$22.6 million, down 3.4% from last year.

KILLEEN - FORT HOOD REGIONAL AIRPORT FUND (KFHRA)

- ➤ KFHRA operating revenues (non-grants) for May was \$158,834 down 24.4% from \$210,000 last year. Year-to-date revenues total \$1,657,316, down 7.9% from \$1,800,474 in the prior year.
- ➤ Other revenues in May include FAA grant funds of \$195,048. The year-to-date total is \$438,129 compared to \$1,525,444 last year.
- ➤ KFHRA operating expenses (non-construction) of \$224,436 are down 13.7% for the month as compared to \$260,020 last year. Year-to-date expenses of \$1,981,374 are down 4.0% from last year's total of \$2,062,867.
- > The ending fund balance for the month was \$1,592,543.

SKYLARK AIRFIELD FUND

- Skylark operating revenues (non-grants) for the month were \$38,382, down 46.8% from \$72,166 last year. Year-to-date revenues of \$369,313 are down 20.4% below last year's total of \$464,066.
- Skylark operating expenses (non-improvements/construction) were \$36,944 for the month, down 47.6% from last year's total of \$70,489. Year-to-date expenses of \$328,494 are down 28.4% from last year's total of \$458,858.
- > The ending fund balance for the month was \$468,988, up from \$453,760 last year.

SOLID WASTE FUND

- ➤ Solid Waste operating revenues were \$1,010,506 for the month, up 3.0% when compared to last May's revenues of \$981,597. Year-to-date revenues of \$7,779,220 are down 1.4% compared to last year's total of \$7,886,266.
- Expenses totaled \$1,123,426 for the month, up 22.3% as compared to \$918,477 last year. Year-to-date expenses are \$8,108,137, up 11.6% from last year's total of \$7,481,692. This increase is largely related to an increase in Transfer Station Operations refuse disposal costs along with other divisional budgeted expenditure increases.
- > The ending fund balance for the month was \$2.7 million, down 41.1% from last year.

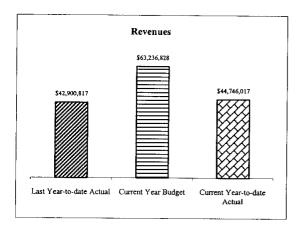
WATER AND SEWER FUND

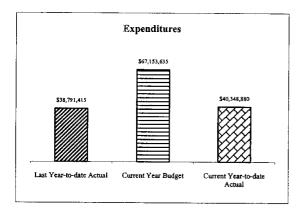
- Water and Sewer operating revenues total \$2,383,191, down 3.0% below last year's revenues of \$2,455,913. Year-to-date revenues total \$18,332,996, below last year's revenues of \$18,930,638 by 3.2%. The variance is primarily due to the slow down in tap fee revenues and the decrease in interest earnings.
- > Tap Fees total \$60,200 for the month, down 52.3% as compared to last year's fees of \$126,102. Year-to-date fees of \$423,090 are below last years total of \$922,818 by 54.2%.
- Expenses total \$1,346,815 for the month, down 41.7% as compared to \$2,308,419 last year. Year-to-date expenses are \$18,196,525, down 5.0% from last year's total of \$19,149,848. This variance is largely due to the timing of the May 2009 monthly contract payment to the Bell County Water Control Improvement District along with a reduction in the Debt Service transfer from the previous fiscal year.
- > The ending fund balance for the month was \$19.5 million, down 2.7% from last year.

DRAINAGE UTILITY FUND

- ➤ Drainage Utility operating revenues total \$249,960 for the month, down 2.6% from last May's revenues of \$256,643. Year-to-date revenues of \$2,031,748 are below last year's revenues of \$2,108,554 by 3.6%. The variance is primarily due to the decrease in interest earnings.
- Residential fees were \$204,557, up 5.1%, and Commercial fees were \$42,176, up 6.2% for the month. For the year, Residential fees are up 3.6% and Commercial fees are up 3.1%.
- ➤ Operating expenses for the month were \$111,026, down 62.1% from \$292,571 last year. Year-to-date expenses are \$1,049,125, down 14.2% from last year's total of \$1,222,611. The decrease in expenses is primarily related to a reduction in Minor drainage projects from last year's operations.
- Major drainage capital improvement project budget is \$6,565,289 with \$30,110 expended in May and \$258,717 expended year-to-date. These projects are funded with the proceeds from the \$8 million Certificate of Obligation issued in June of 2006.
- > The ending fund balance for the month was \$8.9 million, down 5.3% from last year.

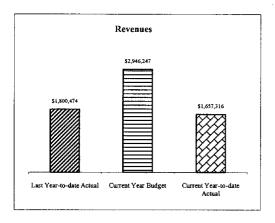

CITY OF KILLEEN ECONOMIC INDICATORS REPORT SUMMARY MAY 2009

There are seven economic indicators monitored by this report. They are 1) Killeen Unemployment Rate, 2) Sales Tax Revenue, 3) Aviation Enplanements and Deplanements, 4) Building Permits, 5) Utility Customers, 6) Water and Sewer Tap Fees, and 7) Hotel Occupancy Tax Revenue. For the month of May 2009, one of the seven economic indicators is positive with Unemployment Rate, Sales Tax Revenue, Aviation Enplanement and Deplanements, Building Permits, Water and Sewer Tap Fees and Hotel Occupancy Tax Revenue being negative.

UNEMPLOYMENT RATE

The unemployment rate for the month of May 2009 was 6.0 as compared to 5.0 during May 2008.

SALES TAX REVENUE

Sales Tax Collections for the month were \$1,812,418, a decrease of 7.2% under last May's collections of \$1,953,800. Year-to-date sales tax collections of \$12,041,847 are below last year's total of \$13,146,336 by 8.4%.

AVIATION ENPLANEMENTS & DEPLANEMENTS

Enplanements for the month total 17,693 an increase of 3.1% as compared to 17,159 during May 2008. Year-to-date enplanements of 122,899 are under last year's total of 128,942 by 4.7%.

Deplanements for the month total 17,919 an increase of 5.8% as compared to 16,929 during May 2008. Year-to-date enplanements of 124,156 are under last year's total of 128,148 by 3.1%.

BUILDING PERMITS

Total dollar value of permits issued for the month was \$22,831,443, a 50.3% decrease under May 2008 dollar value of \$45,945,732. For the month 123 single-family, 5 duplex and 2 multi-family home permits were issued.

UTILITY CUSTOMERS

For the month, the City had 39,851 active utility customers, an increase of 3.3% over the 38,571 active utility customers in May 2008. Finance staff will monitor this data as deployments and re-deployments of Fort Hood troops may have an impact on the City's active utility accounts.

WATER AND SEWER TAP FEES

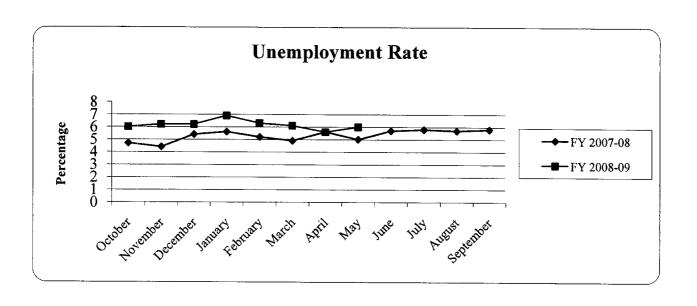
Tap Fees total \$60,200 for the month, down 52.3% as compared to last year's fees of \$126,102. Year to date revenues of \$423,090 are under last year's total of \$922,818 by 54.2%.

HOTEL OCCUPANCY TAX REVENUE

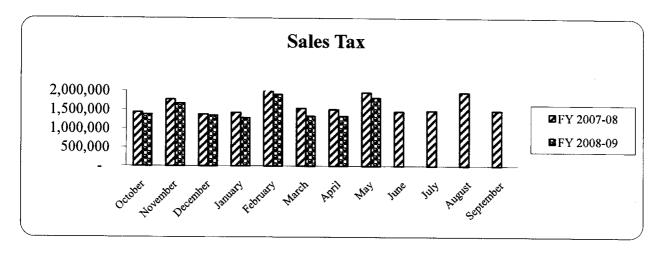
Hotel Occupancy Tax Revenue for the month was \$119,852, down 31.8% under last May's revenue \$175,686. Year to date revenues of \$1,018,464 are below last year's total of \$1,154,566 by 11.8%.

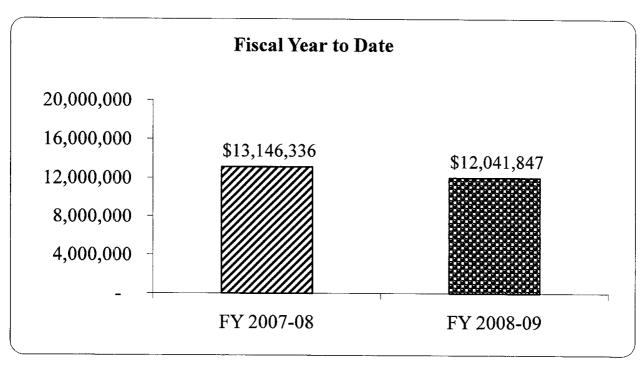

Killeen Municipal Airport Total Passenger Count

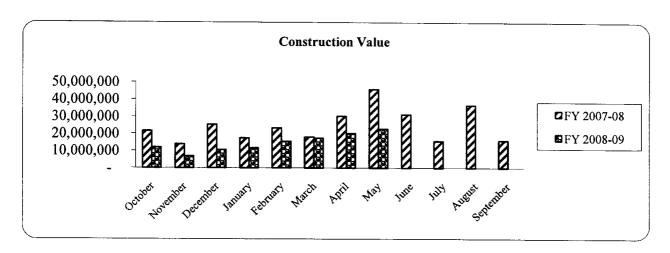






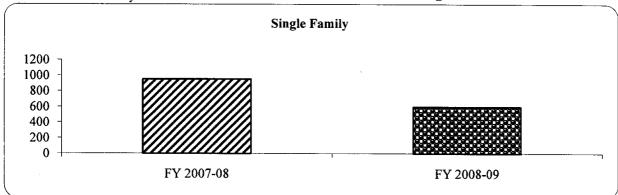
