

Fall Cleanup

Saturday, October 17, 2009 and
Saturday, October 24, 2009

7:00 am until 4:00 pm at the Arlington Landfill, 800 Mosier Valley Road



Free! Arlington residents may take items such as brush, tires, furniture, carpet, lumber, appliances, auto batteries and other bulky waste to the landfill free of charge.

- Proof of Arlington residency is required. A current driver's license and water bill must be presented to dump for free.
- Residents may make unlimited trips free of charge on October 17 and 24.
- Please be sure that items you are transporting to the landfill are tied down and covered.
- No contractors will be allowed to dump for free.
- Children must remain inside vehicles.
- No roofing material.
- Limit of 4 passenger tires.
- No household hazardous waste (HHW) such as paint, pesticides, motor oil, pool chemicals. For information on the proper disposal of HHW, please call 817-459-6777.

Frequently Asked Questions

Q *If I am unable to come to either of the Cleanup Days, will you let me dump at no charge on another day?*

A No. Arlington residents may bring items to the landfill anytime, but the regular fees will be charged. For rates and information please call the landfill at 817-354-2300.

Q *Will you accept large pieces of old concrete at the event?*

A Yes, we will also accept other scrap building materials such as lumber, brick and sheetrock.

Q *Will you accept old tires at the cleanup event?*

A Yes, but there is a limit of four tires per household. If you have more than four you may bring them to the landfill and dispose of them for a fee. There will also be a fee for commercial tires.

Q *Is this event for Arlington residents only?*

A Yes and proof of Arlington residency is required. A current driver's license and a water bill with an Arlington address must be shown upon entering the landfill.

Q *Will you accept old paint or motor oil at the cleanup event?*

A No, household hazardous waste including cooking oil may be taken to the Environmental Collection Center, 6400 Bridge Street in Fort Worth. There is no charge to Arlington residents with proof of residency. The center is open weekly Thurs./ Fri. 11 am to 7 pm and Saturdays 9 am to 3 pm.

Q *We are remodeling our home; will you accept old carpeting, flooring, kitchen sinks, counter tops, etc. at the cleanup event?*

A Yes, the cleanup event is a citywide beautification effort to encourage citizens to clean up around their homes and bring us their hard-to-get-rid-of items such as: old carpet, appliances, scrap metal, whole trees limbs, old fence panels, old lawn mowers (please drain fuel), old barbeque pits (no butane cylinders), lumber, concrete, brick, tires, auto batteries and furniture.

Q *Where can I take old butane or propane cylinders?*

A Amerigas located at 6801 Mitchell Parkway will take them free of charge. They are located in SE Arlington and may be reached at 817-467-1727.

Q *Do you recycle any of the items received at the cleanup event?*

A Yes, we recycle tires, lead acid batteries, scrap metal including appliances, brush and tree limbs.

Q *Do you make mulch from the tree limbs and brush? If so, is that mulch available at no charge to the citizens of Arlington?*

A Tree trimmings disposed of at cleanup events are made into mulch and is available free of charge to Arlington residents (while supplies last) at the Arlington Landfill. Please call 817-354-2300 to find out if mulch is available.
