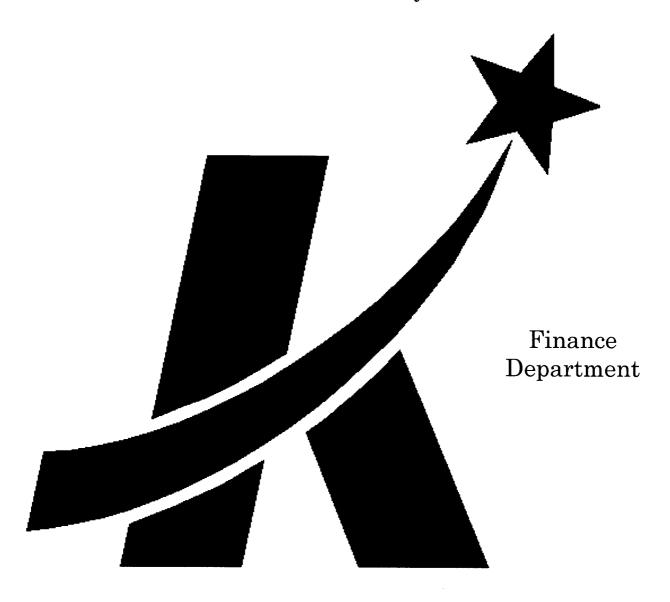

FINANCE DIRECTOR'S REPORT DECEMBER 2008

January 26, 2008

Mayor and City Council Members:

We are pleased to submit the Monthly City Council Financial Report and Executive Summary for the month of December 2008. Finance staff has finished preparing the *Fiscal Year 2008-2009 Annual Budget and Plan of Municipal Services* that will be published and distributed to City Council during the month of February. In addition, the City's independent auditors continue to make progress on the FY 2007-08 annual audit which should be completed in February.

General Fund revenues are meeting budget and staff projections, with 82.4% of the annual ad valorem assessment collected by December 31st. All other major fund operating revenue categories are meeting staff estimates. Total operating expenses for all major funds are on target with staff estimates with no significant variances noted. The Finance Department will work closely with the departments to monitor their revenues and expenses during FY 2008-09 and will present a first quarter financial review in early February.

Key economic indicators of the local economy reflect the recession that our country is currently facing. Two of the seven economic indicators monitored in this monthly report are positive with Unemployment Rate, Sales Tax Revenue, Aviation Enplanement and Deplanements, Building Permits, and Water and Sewer Tap Fees being negative. These indicators are discussed in detail in the attached Economic Indicators Summary Report.

CITY OF KILLEEN FINANCIAL REPORT- DECEMBER 2008 EXECUTIVE SUMMARY MAJOR OPERATING FUNDS

GENERAL FUND

- Revenues total \$3,723,706 for the month, up from last year's revenues of \$3,207,512 by 16.1%. Year-to-date general fund revenues of \$26,286,043 are up 11.4% over last year's total of \$23,586,866. The year-to-date variance is primarily attributable to property tax revenues.
- Sales Tax Collections for the month were \$1,349,159, a decrease of 1.7% from last December's collections of \$1,372,391. Year-to-date sales tax collections of \$4,509,612 are below last year's total of \$4,734,864 by 4.8%.
- ➤ Property Tax Collections during the month were \$878,664, an increase over last year's collections of \$643,410 by 36.6%. Year-to-date property tax receipts of \$17,638,802 exceed last years total of \$14,933,717 by 18.1%.
- Franchise Fees collected during December were \$323,348 compared to \$1,794 last December. Year-to-date franchise revenues are \$470,286, up 26.7% over last year's total of \$371,144.
- Permits & Inspections fees collected during December totaled \$79,329, down 35.7% from last year's revenue of \$123,320. Year-to-date revenues of \$226,228 are 29.8% below last year's total of \$322,068.
- Court fines and fees were \$156,096 during December, up 22.0% over the prior year collections of \$127,905. Year-to-date revenues total \$508,305, 10.8% above last year's total of \$458,783.
- Interest Earned during December totaled \$56,114, a decrease of 60.3% from last December's interest earnings of \$141,489. Year-to-date interest earnings total \$174,717, 55.3% below last year's total of \$390,885.
- Total expenditures for December are \$4,597,807, 3.9% above \$4,439,018 last year. Year-to-date expenditures of \$15,070,559 are up 5.2% when compared to last year's expenditures of \$14,324,932.
- The ending fund balance for the month was \$30.5 million, up 6.9% from last year.

KILLEEN - FORT HOOD REGIONAL AIRPORT FUND (KFHRA)

- ➤ KFHRA operating revenues (non-grants) for December was \$252,131 down 21.2% from \$319,970 last year. Year-to-date revenues total \$642,242, down 7.3% from \$692,842 in the prior year.
- > Other revenues in December include FAA grant funds of \$211,417.
- ➤ KFHRA operating expenses (non-construction) of \$228,901 were up 3.8% for the month as compared to \$220,583 last year. Year-to-date expenses of \$706,134 are up 0.6% from last year's total of \$701,624.
- The ending fund balance for the month was \$862,343, down 19.3% from last year.

SKYLARK AIRFIELD FUND

- Skylark operating revenues (non-grants) for the month were \$49,220, down 16.4% from \$58,844 last year. Year-to-date revenues of \$151,668 are down 17.8% from last year's total of \$184,443.
- Skylark operating expenses (non-improvements/construction) were \$32,096 for the month, down 27.6% from last year's total of \$44,320. Year-to-date expenses of \$142,557 are down 12.6% from last year's total of \$163,149.
- > The ending fund balance for the month was \$437,280, down 7.6% from \$473,024 last year.

SOLID WASTE FUND

- ➤ Solid Waste operating revenues were \$1,259,574 for the month, up 45.7% when compared to last December's revenues of \$864,346. This increase is largely attributable to the timing of the November end of the month customer billing which was recorded in December as opposed to last year's being recorded in November. Year-to-date revenues of \$2,940,478 are up 3.2% compared to last year's total of \$2,850,523.
- Expenses totaled \$916,215 for the month, up 6.9% as compared to \$857,212 last year. Year-to-date expenses are \$2,743,646 up 8.7% from last year's total of \$2,524,435. This increase is largely related to an increase in Transfer Station Operations refuse disposal costs.
- > The ending fund balance for the month was \$4.3 million, down 2.9% from last year.

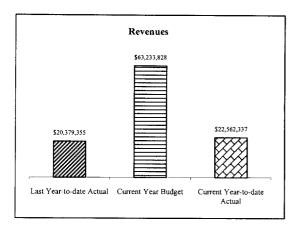
WATER AND SEWER FUND

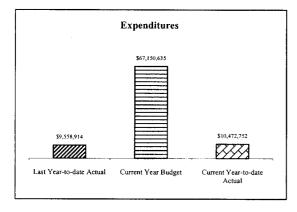
- Water and Sewer operating revenues total \$2,744,250, up 33.0% over last year's revenues of \$2,062,810. This increase is largely attributable to the timing of the November end of the month customer billing which was recorded in December as opposed to last year's being recorded in November. Year-to-date revenues total \$7,410,547, up from last year's revenues of \$7,104,759 by 4.3%.
- Tap Fees total \$34,025 for the month, down 37.0% as compared to last year's fees of \$54,008. Year-to-date fees of \$132,265 are down from last years total of \$249,701 by 47.0%.
- Expenses total \$2,176,553 for the month, up 8.2% as compared to \$2,011,697 last year. Year-to-date expenses are \$7,279,893, up 5.0% from last year's total of \$6,933,308.
- The ending fund balance for the month was \$19.5 million, down 4.6% from last year.

DRAINAGE UTILITY FUND

- ➤ Drainage Utility operating revenues total \$301,072 for the month, up 23.4% over last December's revenues of \$244,031. This increase is largely attributable to the timing of the November end of the month customer billing which was recorded in December as opposed to last year's being recorded in November. Year-to-date revenues of \$769,009 are below last year's revenues of \$774,907 by 0.8%.
- Residential fees year-to-date were \$593,445, up 7.7%, and Commercial fees year-to-date were \$126,046, up 7.6% for the year as compared to last fiscal year.
- ➤ Operating expenses for the month were \$87,413, up 3.3% as compared to \$84,642 last year. Year-to-date expenses are \$251,785, up 20.3% from last year's total of \$209,391.
- Major drainage capital improvement project budget is \$6,573,571 with \$70,151 expended in December. These projects are funded with the proceeds from the \$8 million Certificate of Obligation issued in June of 2006.
- > The ending fund balance for the month was \$8.6 million, down 6.4% from last year.

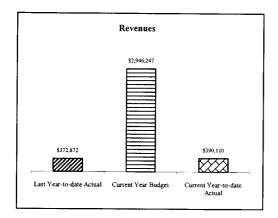

CITY OF KILLEEN ECONOMIC INDICATORS REPORT SUMMARY DECEMBER 2008

There are seven economic indicators monitored by this report. They are 1) Killeen Unemployment Rate, 2) Sales Tax Revenue, 3) Aviation Enplanements and Deplanements, 4) Building Permits, 5) Utility Customers, 6) Water and Sewer Tap Fees, and 7) Hotel Occupancy Tax Revenue. For the month of December 2008, two of the seven economic indicators are positive with Unemployment Rate, Sales Tax Revenue, Aviation Enplanement and Deplanements, Building Permits, and Water and Sewer Tap Fees being negative.

UNEMPLOYMENT RATE

The unemployment rate for the month of December 2008 was 6.2 as compared to 5.4 during December 2007.

SALES TAX REVENUE

Sales Tax Collections for the month were \$1,349,159, a decrease of 1.7% under last December's collections of \$1,372,391. Year-to-date sales tax collections of \$4,388,633 are below last year's total of \$4,571,700 by 4.0%.

AVIATION ENPLANEMENTS & DEPLANEMENTS

Enplanements for the month total 15,811 a decrease of 1.4% as compared to 16,030 during December 2007. Year-to-date enplanements of 45,520 are under last year's total of 48,900 by 6.9%.

Deplanements for the month total 16,688, an increase of 12.9% as compared to 14,787 during December 2007. Year-to-date deplanements of 47,055 are under last year's total of 48,553 by 3.1%.

BUILDING PERMITS

Total dollar value of permits issued for the month was \$10,494,128, a 58.5% decrease under December 2007 dollar value of \$25,263,344. For the month 47 single-family and no duplex or multi-family home permits were issued.

UTILITY CUSTOMERS

For the month, the City had 38,290 active utility customers, an increase of 2.0% over the 37,531 active utility customers in December 2007. Finance staff will monitor this data as deployments and redeployments of Fort Hood troops may have an impact on the City's active utility accounts.

WATER AND SEWER TAP FEES

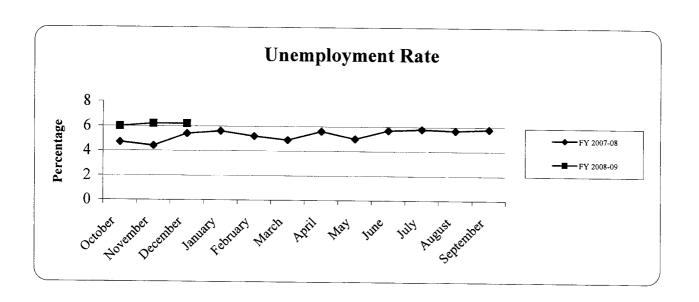
Tap Fees total \$34,025 for the month, down 37.0% as compared to last year's fees of \$54,008. Year to date revenues of \$132,265 are under last year's total of \$249,701 by 47.0%.

HOTEL OCCUPANCY TAX REVENUE

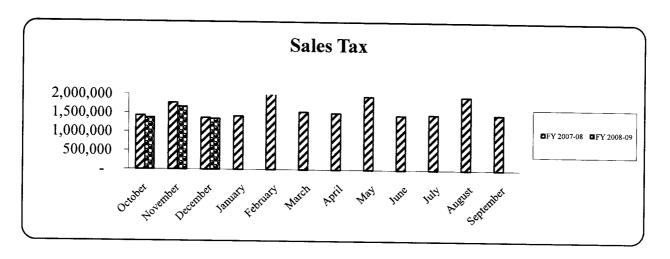
Hotel Occupancy Tax Revenue for the month was \$156,865, up 32.8% above last December's revenue of \$118,094. Year to date revenues of \$377,417 are above last year's total of \$354,713 by 6.4%.

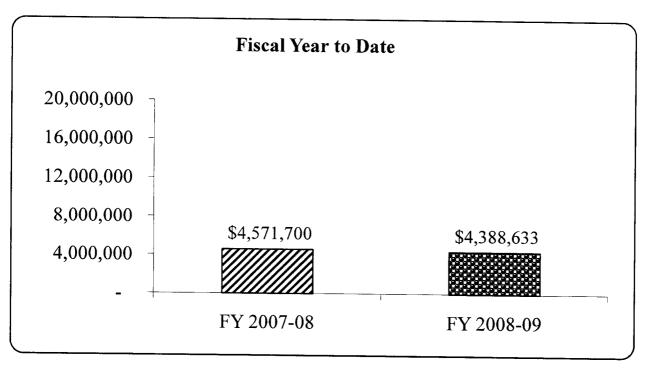

Killeen Municipal Airport Total Passenger Count

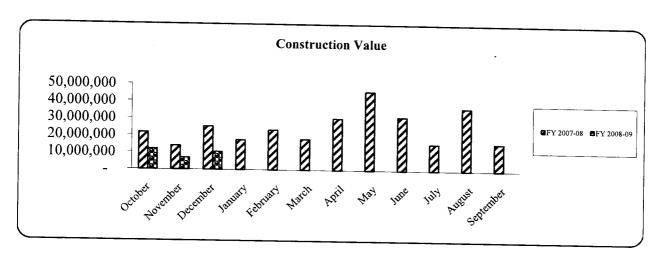






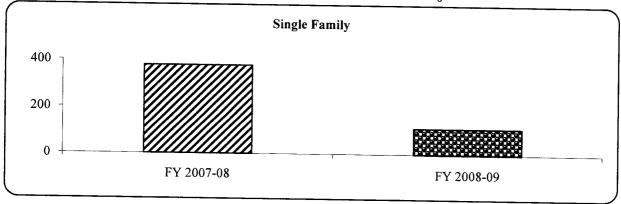
