The City of Freeport requires a certificate of insurance, in accordance with the State Board of Plumbing and The City of Freeport Code of Ordinance, to be on file and updated at all times with the City of Freeport.

In accordance with the State Board of License:

Article 6243-101

(c) A certificate of insurance must:

- (1) be written by a company licensed to do business in this state;
- (2) provide for commercial general liability insurance for the master plumber for claims for property damage or bodily injury, regardless of whether the claim arises from a negligence claim or on a contract claim; and
- (3) be in a coverage amount of not less than \$300,000 for all claims arising in any one-year period.

(d) When a person is issued a master plumber's license, the person must provide the Board with a certificate of insurance that meets the requirements of Subsection (c) before the person works as a master plumber.

In accordance with the Code of Ordinances for the City of Freeport:

150.047

Every licensed plumber and every lawn sprinkler installer shall obtain and maintain on file with the Building Official, at all times when working in the city, certificates (in which city is named as certificate holder) certifying that such installer has in force the following insurance company licensed to do business in the state:

- (a) Worker's compensation insurance on each and every employee as required and in accordance with the worker's compensation law of the state.
