Tomball Comprehensive Plan

In October 2008, Tomball City Council approved the Tomball Comprehensive Plan proposal, which is a year long community-driven planning effort to develop a long-range vision for the future growth and development of the City.

When completed, the Plan will be a policy tool used by the City to address zoning changes, infrastructure improvements, transportation & mobility concerns, annexations, and other considerations related to land development. Input and participation from residents, businesses and landowners is critical to ensure the Plan is representative of the community. All are encouraged to participate in a variety of public involvement activities throughout 2009.

May will be a fun and exciting month in the Comprehensive Planning process!! May 5-7 we will be hosting an "*Urban Design Studio*" from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. at the Tomball Community Center. At this event the public is invited to stop by any time throughout the day to discuss urban design concepts and create the framework for future growth and development. From 6-8 p.m. on May 5, there will be a "*Futures Forum*" meeting open to the general public at Tomball High School to discuss strategic planning opportunities for our community and hear from a keynote speaker about the value a Comprehensive Plan brings to a rapidly growing community.

On May 6, from 6 to 9 p.m., we will be hosting a community "*Town Hall Event*" at Tomball High School. Citizens will be given the opportunity to be a "planner for the evening" by creating land use and transportation alternatives to be considered for the Comp Plan. The week's activities will be capped off with the "*Futures Forum Results Presentation*" on May 7 from 6 to 8 p.m. at Tomball High School where the results of the week's meetings will be presented and discussion will take place on the comments and ideas received.

Code Red

The City of Tomball has contracted with Emergency Communications Network, Inc., for its "CodeRED" high speed telephone emergency notification services. The CodeRED system gives city officials the ability to deliver pre-recorded emergency telephone notification/information messages to targeted areas or the entire city at a rate of up to 60,000 calls per hour.

To ensure no one is omitted. Chief Parr urges all individuals and businesses to log onto the City of Tomball's website, www.ci.tomball.tx.us, and follow the link to the "CodeRED Residential and Business Data Collection" page. Those without Internet access may call Tomball's Emergency Management Office (281-351-7101), Monday through Friday, (8AM-5PM) to give their information over the phone. Required information includes first and last name, street address (physical address, no P.O. boxes), city, state, zip code, and primary phone number, additional phone numbers and e-mail address (optional).



City Recycling

Tomball now has 4 paper recycling locations available to the citizens of Tomball at the City Hall parking lot, Police Department parking lot, Public Works front parking lot and at the Central Fire Station on Rudel Road.

We encourage all citizens to utilize these paper recycling bins. Cardboard boxes are accepted only if they are broken down. You can put shredded paper in plastic bags if the bags have holes to allow the air to escape.


