The National Association of Town Watch (NATW) has announced that the "26th Annual National Night Out (NNO) program will culminate on Tuesday, October 6th, 2009. NNO 2008 involved 37 million people in 15,449 communities from all 50 states, U.S. territories, Canadian cities, and military bases worldwide. National Night Out 2009 is expected to be the largest ever. NNO is sponsored by NATW in partnership with Target .National Night Out, a, is designed to: (1) Heighten crime prevention awareness; (2) Generate support for, and participation in local anticrime programs; (3) Strengthen neighborhood spirit and police-community partnerships; and (4) Send a message to criminals letting them know that neighborhoods are organized and fighting back. Along with the traditional outside lights and front porch vigils, most cities and towns now celebrate National Night Out with a variety of special citywide and neighborhood events such as block parties, cookouts, parades, festivals, visits from local law enforcement, safety fairs, and youth events.

The Tomball Police Department, Tomball Fire Department, Northwest EMS, Tomball Public Works and Target Representatives will be visiting 10 neighborhoods inside the City Limits of Tomball beginning at 7pm until 9pm to network and support the citizens in their quest for a safe community.

- Each neighborhood participating will receive a banner and art supplies to create their "NNO Parade Banner".
- Each neighborhood will have a 1 block "parade route" and will have a neighborhood theme color of either RED, WHITE or BLUE.
- Each neighborhood should urge residents to bring their flashlights

All of our first responders are looking forward to visiting each of your neighborhoods and witness our HOMETOWN with a HEART come together for an evening of fun.
