 - 7.1 Motion was made by Councilman Townsend, second by Councilman Driver to read Ordinance No. 2009-18, by caption only, on first reading.

Motion was made by Councilman Driver, second by Councilman Stoll, to Adopt, on First Reading, Ordinance No. 2009-18, An Ordinance Altering the Prima Facie Speed Limits Established for Vehicles under the Provisions of §545.356, Texas Transportation Code, upon the Basis of an Engineering and Traffic Investigation, upon Certain Streets and Highways, or Parts Thereof, within the Corporate Limits of the City Of Tomball, as set out in this Ordinance; and Providing a Penalty of a Fine in an Amount not less than One Dollar (\$1.00) or more than Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for the Violation of this Ordinance (SH 249/Tomball Expressway).

Motion was made by Councilman Townsend, second by Councilman Driver, to table consideration of Ordinance No. 2009-18, pending additional information from TxDOT regarding rationale for speed limits and accident information.

Motion carried unanimously; Ordinance No. 2009-18 tabled.

7.2 Motion was made by Councilman Quinn, second by Councilman Driver to re-appoint Latrell Shannon and Leonard Chambers to the Tomball Hospital Authority Board of Directors, as recommended by Mayor Fagan.

7.3 Motion was made by Councilman Driver, second by Councilman Townsend to Receive City Manager's Vested Rights Determination Letter dated July 15, 2009, regarding the Tomball South Commercial Project.

Motion carried unanimously.

7.4 Motion was made by Councilman Stoll, second by Councilman Townsend for Council Consideration to Set August 17, 2009 as the Public Hearing Date for the City of Tomball's Proposed Budget for FY 2010.

7.5 Mark McClure provided an overview regarding the Crofoot Farms Replat. Motion was made by Councilman Driver, second by Councilman Stoll, to approve <u>CROFOOT</u> <u>FARMS REPLAT</u>: To create 2 lots (4.2676 acres) out of the Residue of Outlot 34 of Tomball Outlots according to the Map or Plat thereof recorded in Vol. 2, Pg. 65, Map Records, Harris County, Texas; situated in the Ralph Hubbard Survey, Abstract 383, Harris County, Texas.

Motion carried unanimously.

7.6 Mark McClure provided an overview regarding the Neal Falls Final Plat. Motion was made by Councilman Townsend, second by Councilman Driver to approve <u>NEAL FALLS</u> <u>FINAL PLAT</u>; Being a 1.913-acre tract of land described under Harris County Clark's File Number 20080088010 and a 2.0959-acre tract of land described under Harris County Clerk's File Number 20070661730 into a subdivision of a 3.9386-acre tract of land, situated in the John Soper Smith Survey Abstract 730, Harris County, Texas

Motion carried unanimously.

7.7 Discussion was conducted by Councilmembers regarding Media Coverage of *Grand Texas* Theme Park, as requested by Councilman Webb. Monty Galland, Developer, gave a PowerPoint presentation regarding the proposed theme park and responded to Council questions. No action taken.

- 7.8 Discussion was conducted by Councilmembers regarding the City Charter Provisions for a Volunteer Fire Department, as requested by Councilman Townsend. Randy Parr and Scott Bounds provided information regarding Charter provisions as they apply to the Tomball Fire Department. The City may maintain either a paid or a volunteer fire department, or a combination of paid and volunteer firefighting forces, as is the current situation. No action taken.
- 7.9 Discussion of the loss of the appointment of the position to the FBI/RCFL program and the impact this loss will have on the City of Tomball, as requested by Councilmen Stoll and Townsend. Robert Hauck provided an overview of the program as it was originally established and as it currently exists. No action taken.

Mayor Fagan called a 10-minute break at 8:40 p.m.; upon reconvening in regular session, the following items were considered:

7.10 Discussion was held regarding the Adoption of City Council Leadership Covenant, as developed during the Strategic Workshop. Motion was made by Councilman Townsend, second by Councilman Stoll, to adopt the City Council Leadership Covenant, with an amendment to Covenant 5, to read, "The Tomball City Council will maintain political will to do what is right for citizens of Tomball". Councilmembers requested a form for use in requesting that an item be placed on the next agenda; use of the form must not constitute a "walking quorum". City Attorney will consider and provide options to Council. No action taken.
- 8.0 Motion was made by Councilman Townsend, second by Councilman Stoll, to adjourn.
