3.0 COUNCIL ENTERED INTO WORKSHOP TO DISCUSS THE DOWNTOWN REVITALIZATION PROJECT WITH PROJECT ENGINEER, ROBERT PEDERSON

AN OVERVIEW OF THE PROJECT WAS PRESENTED BY BEN GRIFFIN. SCOPE OF PHASE I INCLUDES THREE (3) ONE-BLOCK AREAS:

- A. ELM STREET, NORTH FROM MAIN STREET TO COMMERCE
- B. ELM STREET, SOUTH FROM MAIN STREET TO DEPOT SITE
- C. MAIN STREET, BOTH SIDES FROM ELM TO WALNUT STREET.

CONSTRUCTION OF RESTROOM FACILITIES HAS BEEN REMOVED FROM PHASE I OF THE PROJECT. READY TO BID OUT WITHIN NEXT 3-4 WEEKS; SHOULD BE ABLE TO BEGIN CONSTRUCTION SHORTLY THEREAFTER. MINUTES COUNCIL WORKSHOP JULY 6, 2004 PAGE 2 OF 2

> ROBERT PEDERSON RECOMMENDED REPLACING FIVE OAKS TREES IN PHASE I WITH TEN SHUMARD OAKS. EAST SIDE OF ELM WILL CONTAIN PARKING. PHASE I INCLUDES LANDSCAPING, JOGGING TRAIL, RELOCATION OF CRAPE MYRTLES, RELOCATING DEPOT AND AMPITHEATER AREA. DEPOT WILL BE PRESERVED AS HISTORICAL SITE; TRACK WILL BE INCLUDED FOR CABOOSE. PAVING WILL BE STAMPED CONCRETE, SIDEWALKS WILL BE 8-FT. WIDE IN FRONT OF SHOPS, WITH TREES, SIGNAGE, ETC.

> CONCENSUS OF COUNCIL IS TO REMOVE FIVE OAK TREES ON MAIN STREET AND REPLACE WITH TEN UNIFORMLY-SIZED SHUMARD OAKS TREES. CITY STAFF WILL OBTAIN BIDS FOR REMOVING AND REPLANTING EXISTING OAK TREES ELSEWHERE AND FOR REMOVING OAKS TREES AND REPLACING WITH NEW SHUMARD OAK TREES.
