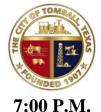
MINUTES OF REGULAR CITY COUNCIL MEETING CITY OF TOMBALL, TEXAS

8.1 The Public Hearing to Consider ZONING CASE P08-006: Request by Sam Pisano, on behalf of Persimmon Development Partners, LLC and MICO Group LTD to rezone approximately 4.3265 acres, legally described as Vasquez-Phoenix Subdivision, Block 2, Lots 1, 2 and 3, located on the northwest corner of Lizzie Lane and South Persimmon Street from the SF-6-Single-Family 6 District to the C-Commercial District (1028 & 1032 Lizzie Lane and 702 South Persimmon Street) was opened by Mayor Fagan at 7:21 p.m.

No public comments were received and the public hearing was closed at 7:21 p.m.

8.2 Motion was made by Councilman Webb to Approve **ZONING CASE P08-006**: Request by Sam Pisano, on behalf of Persimmon Development Partners, LLC and MICO Group LTD to rezone approximately 4.3265 acres of land, legally described as Lots 1, 2 and 3 of Block 2 of the Vasquez-Phoenix Subdivision, a subdivision within the City of Tomball, Harris County, Texas, located on the northwest corner of Lizzie Lane and South Persimmon Street from the SF-6-Single-Family 6 District to the C-Commercial District. (1028 and 1032 Lizzie Lane and 702 South Persimmon Street); second by Councilman Driver.

Motion was made by Councilman Webb to Adopt, on First Reading, Ordinance No. 2008-05, an Ordinance of the City of Tomball, Texas, Amending Its Comprehensive Zoning Ordinance by Changing the Zoning District Classification of Approximately

4.3265 Acres of Land in the Vasquez-Phoenix Subdivision, Harris County, Texas, from SF-6-Single Family 6 District to C-Commercial District; Said Property also Being Known as Lots 1, 2 And 3 of Block 2 of the Vasquez-Phoenix Subdivision Located at the Northwest Corner of Lizzie Lane and South Persimmon Street; Providing for the Amendment of the Official Zoning Map of the City; Providing for Severability; Providing for a Penalty of an Amount Not to Exceed \$2,000 for Each Day of Violation of Any Provision Hereof; Making Findings of Fact; and Providing for Other Related Matters; second by Councilman Harvey. Motion was made by Councilman Driver to Adopt, on First Reading, Ordinance No. 2008-06, an Ordinance of the City of Tomball, Texas, Finding and Determining that Public Convenience and Necessity No Longer Require the Continued Existence of the Remainder of a 30-Foot Unimproved Road Right-of-Way, More Fully Described in Volume 2, Page 65 of the Harris County Map Records and Within the Tomball Townsite Subdivision, Harris County, Texas, Vacating, Abandoning, and Closing the Remainder of Said 30-Foot Unimproved Road Right-of-Way; Authorizing the Mayor to Execute and the City Secretary to Attest, Respectively, a Quitclaim Deed Conveying Said Abandoned Road Right-of-Way to 2978 Industrial Partners, LLC; and Containing Other Provisions Relating to the Subject; second by Councilman Lazenby. 8.6 Motion was made by Councilman Driver to Approve Administrative Policy No. 20, Entitled "Travel and Expense Reimbursement Policy"; second by Councilman Harvey.

8.7 Motion was made by Councilman Webb to Adopt Resolution No. 2008-07, a Resolution Declaring the Intention of the City of Tomball, Texas, to Institute Proceedings to Annex Certain Territory; Describing Such Territory; Setting the Dates, Times, and Places for Two Public Hearings at Which all Interested Parties Shall Have an Opportunity to be Heard; Providing for Publication of Notices of Such Public Hearings; and Directing Preparation of a Municipal Service Plan for the Territory Proposed to be Annexed (70.5113 Acres Located South of Holderrieth Road – M118 Drainage Channel) and setting May 19, 2008 and May 27, 2008 as the dates of the public hearings; second by Councilman Lazenby.

8.8 Motion was made by Councilman Webb to Adopt Resolution No. 2008-08, a Resolution Declaring the Intention of the City of Tomball, Texas, to Institute Proceedings to Annex Certain Territory; Describing Such Territory; Setting the Dates, Times, and Places for Two Public Hearings at Which all Interested Parties Shall Have an Opportunity to be Heard; Providing for Publication of Notices of Such Public Hearings; and Directing Preparation of a Municipal Service Plan for the Territory Proposed to be Annexed (44.787 Acres Located at the Southwest Corner of Brown Road and State Highway 249 – Brown Road Timber Resources) and setting May 19, 2008 and May 27, 2008 as the dates of the public hearings; second by Councilman Quinn.

Motion carried unanimously.
