Pillot Survey, A-632, Harris County, Texas, from AG-Agricultural District to O-Office District; said Property also being Known as Tracts 4A and 4A-3, as Recorded in H.C.F.C # 038706, in the C.N. Pillot Survey, A-632, Located on the Easterly Side of South Cherry Street, Northerly of Holderrieth Road; Providing for the Amendment of the Official Zoning Map of the City; Providing for Severability; Providing for a Penalty of an Amount Not to Exceed \$2,000 for Each Day of Violation of Any Provision Hereof; Making Findings of Fact; and Providing for Other Related Matters; second by Councilman Lazenby.
