



Community Moving Toward a Final Land Use Plan

August 6, 2009—From the collaborative efforts of residents and stakeholders, Tomball's Comprehensive Plan continues to move closer to a final product. On June 24, 2009, the Alternatives Workshop provided participants the opportunity to provide feedback on three potential land use scenarios. Participants were excited about a number of elements put forth in the draft scenarios, including an emphasis on mixed-use development in Downtown and Four Corners areas. Attendees also suggested use of existing rights-of-way for a trail system that could be implemented incrementally and minimize costs. Attendee feedback from each of the land considerations were instrumental in the development of the preferred alternative for Tomball's future land use.

On Wednesday, August 12 at 6:00 PM at the Tomball Community Center, the planning team will present the draft preferred land use plan crafted from feedback received to date and analysis conducted. In addition to guiding how Tomball will look in the future, participants will have an opportunity to review policies and contribute to implementation strategies.
