TOMBALL MUNICIPAL COURT TO PARTICIPATE IN GREAT TEXAS WARRANT ROUNDUP

The City of Tomball Municipal Court advises residents that it is joining other cities around Texas as a participant in the "Great Texas Warrant Round Up." The program is specifically designed as a concentrated statewide effort to arrest anyone with outstanding warrants pending before their respective courts.

Law enforcement agencies and cities throughout the state conduct roundups at different times throughout the year, focusing on violators with outstanding Class C misdemeanor warrants. Defendants with unpaid traffic, city ordinance violations, penal code and higher charge warrants will be targeted in the first state-wide warrant round up ever conducted in Texas, which is set to launch Saturday, March 03, 2007.

Tomball Police Departments plans to actively participate in this effort. Regardless if you are at home, work, or school, if you have an outstanding warrant, you will go to jail. Affected persons are urged to contact the appropriate jurisdiction to dispose of their cases voluntarily and avoid the inconvenience and embarrassment of arrest in front of family, friends, or co-workers.

Warrants from City of Tomball Municipal Court can be paid Monday through Friday from 8:00 A.M. - 4:00 P.M. at 401 Market in Tomball. Visa and MasterCard payments may be are accepted. Payments may also be mailed to Tomball Municipal Court, 401 Market, Tomball, Texas.
