
Calls for Service

During 2008, the Tomball Police Department Communications Center logged 31,784 events containing officer activity. This number includes traffic stops, foot patrols, suspicious persons and citizen-generated calls for service requiring a police response. Of the 31,784 events logged, the top five activities included traffic stops, foot patrols, jail inspections, suspicious persons and information calls. Below you will find an additional breakdown of Tomball Police Department dispatch activities for 2008:

- > Tomball Police Officers completed 2,716 written reports.
- > Tomball Communications Specialists confirmed 1,679 warrants.
- > The Communications Specialists answered 37,252 citizen calls.
- > There were 8,159 dispatched Citizen Calls for Service.
- > The average call for service response time was 4 minutes 05 seconds. The average response time in 2007 was 4 minutes, 18 seconds.
