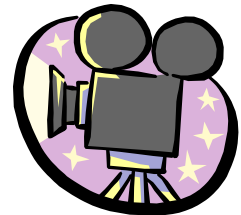

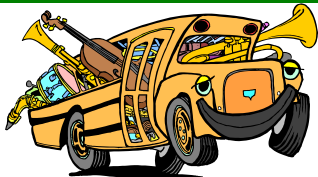


## 55+ Precinct 4 Bus Travel Plans
