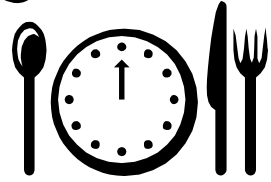

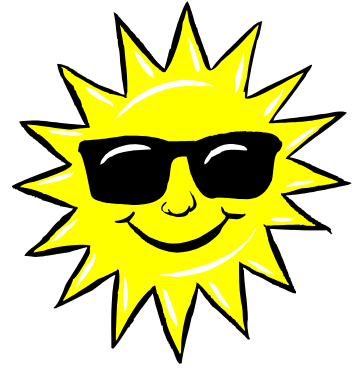
## **ATTENTION: CITY EMPLOYEES**

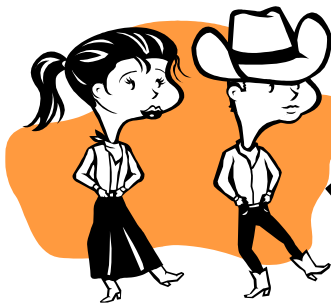

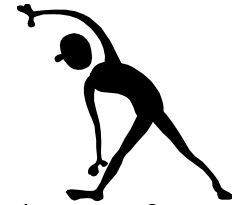


# LINEDANCING
