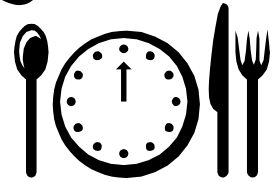

H HALLOWEEN TREATS FOR KIDS

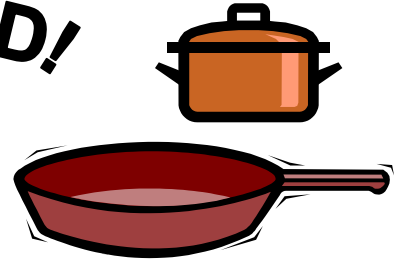
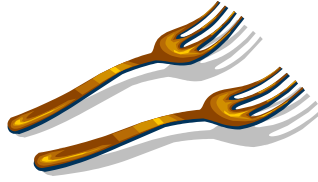

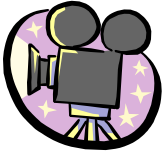


FALL FESTIVAL

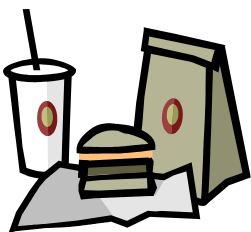

Not feeling “up to snuff?”

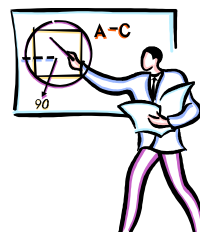

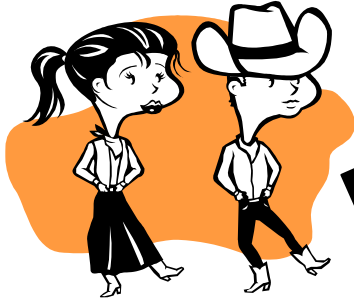


ROMEO'S

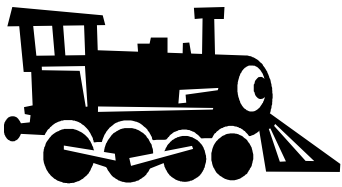
LINEDANCING



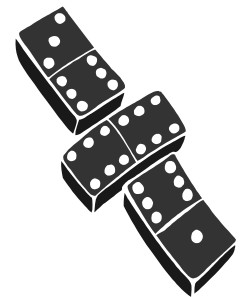
