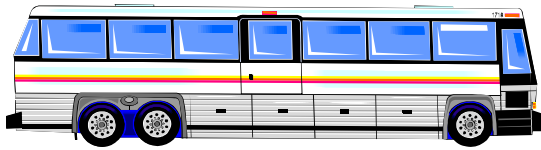

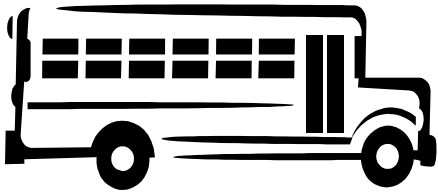
Travel Meeting – No meeting this month.

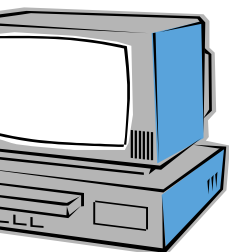

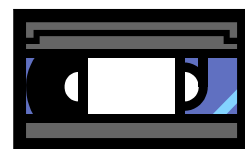

LEARN TO PLAY "PENNIES"

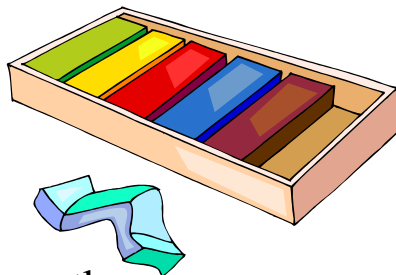

"PANCHO'S"

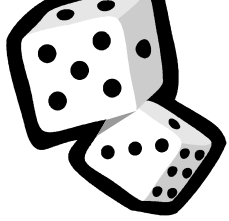
