BINGO!

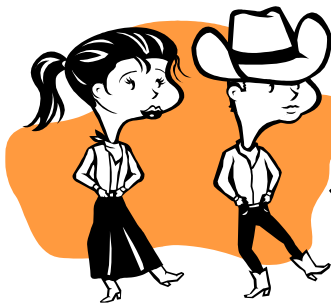
APRIL 12th

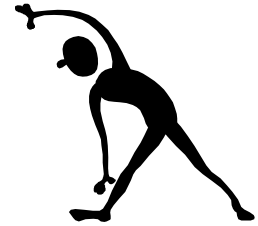


LINEDANCING

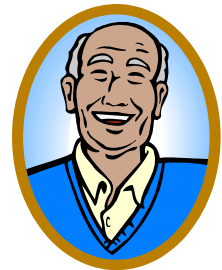
TEXAS CITY TRIP

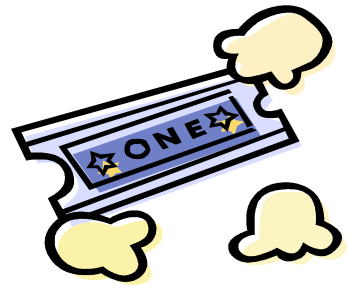
• FOOLS GAME DAY •

APRIL 5TH

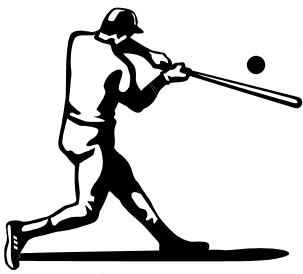


The Center will be showing “Apollo 13” starting at 1p.m. We will furnish popcorn and you bring your drink. Please sign up before the 4th.

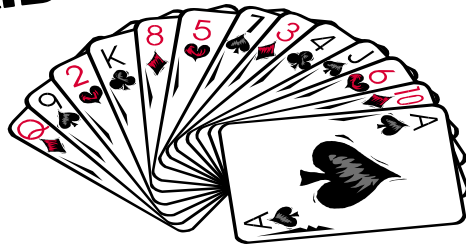


• **BALLGAME TIME!**

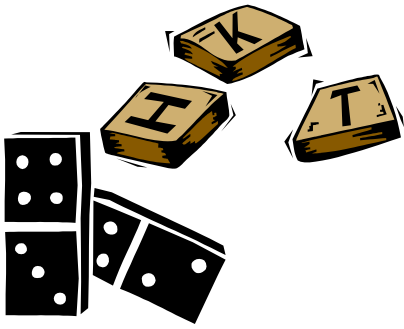
BRIDGE TOURNAMENT



There will be a tournament at Doss Community Center on May 31st from 10 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.

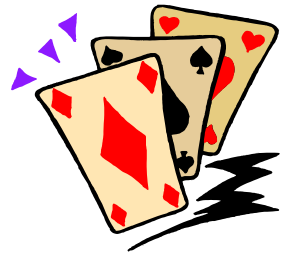

You are welcome to eat lunch at **noon** with us for a cost of \$5.00 (unless otherwise noted).

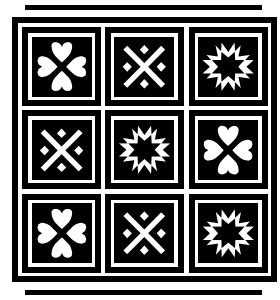
If you would like to eat with us you will need to come by the office to register and pay two days prior to the Center buying the groceries.

Sorry, but cancellations made after groceries are bought and all “no shows” will forfeit your money.



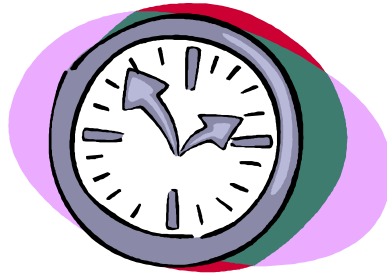
