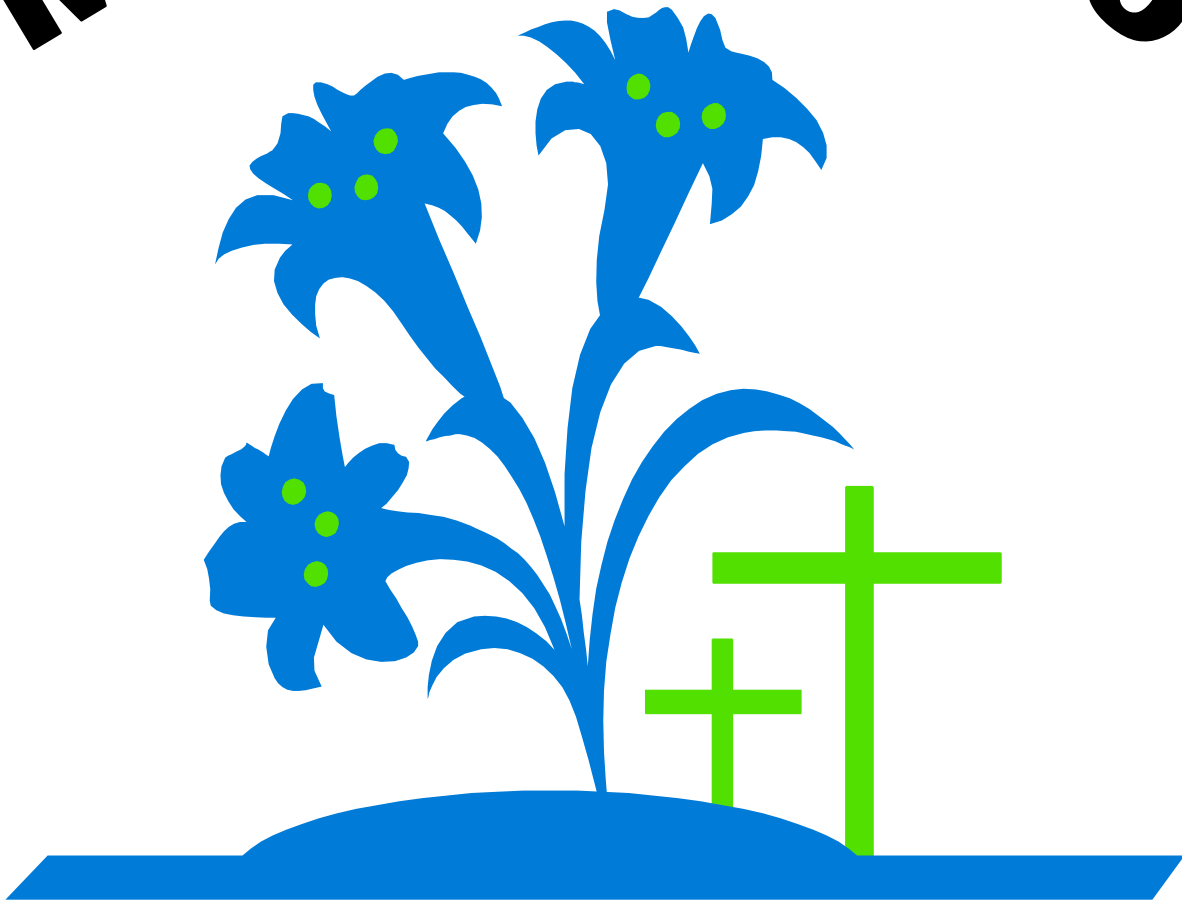

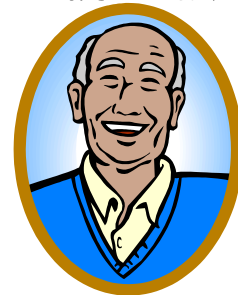
CENTER’S BUS – 18 & UP

7 A.M. – 2P.M.

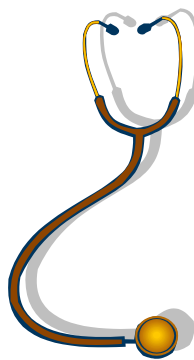


WHO: The fair is open to all employees. The testing is restricted to all full time employees and their spouses who are enrolled in our TML medical insurance.

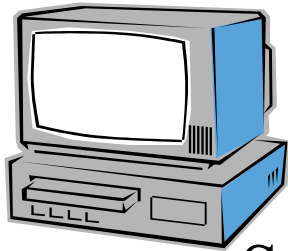

WILD BUNCH RIDING & ROPING CLUB



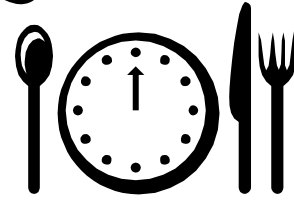

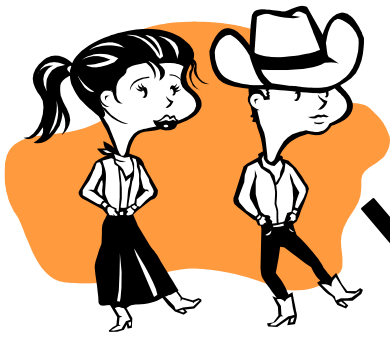
MARCH 19TH & 20TH

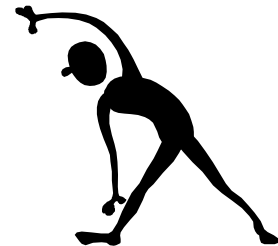


LINEDANCING

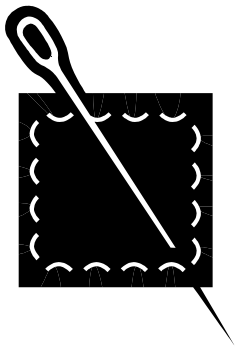

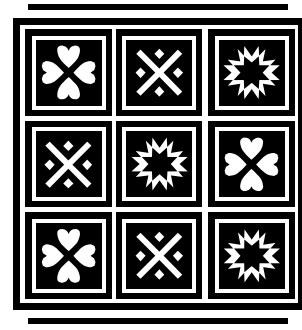
MORE EXERCISE

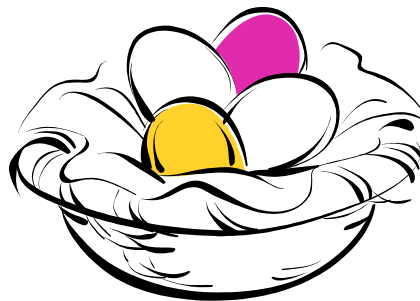
