Mmmm Good! Come by the front office and sign up before August 25<sup>th</sup> for a delicious root beer float for only a \$1.00. Open for 18 & up.



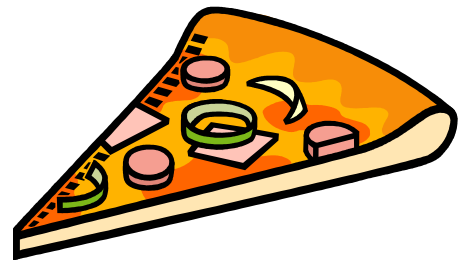
# BINGO!

AUGUST 5<sup>th</sup>

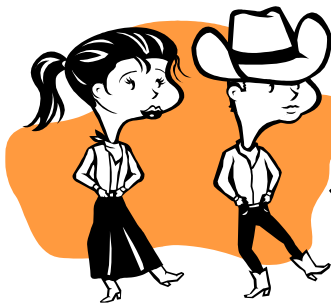
We will start playing bingo at 1 p.m. sharp for all ages that would like to join us for a hour of fun. We will be giving away prizes. Bring a friend and come on down.

We will be having a pizza social starting at 11:45a.m. Please sign up in the office before August 15<sup>th</sup>. The cost is only \$2.00.

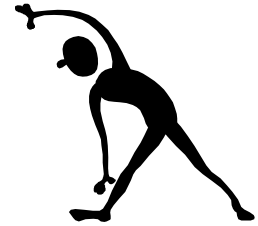


# LINEDANCING

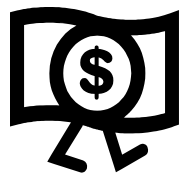
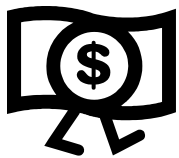
# **GROUP PICTURE**

# **WALK-A-THON**



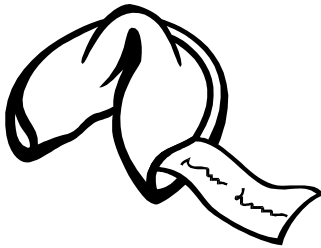

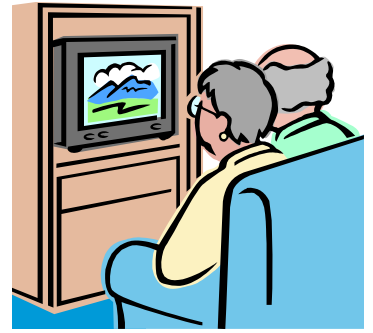

# MOVIE DAY

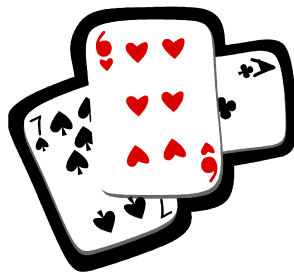

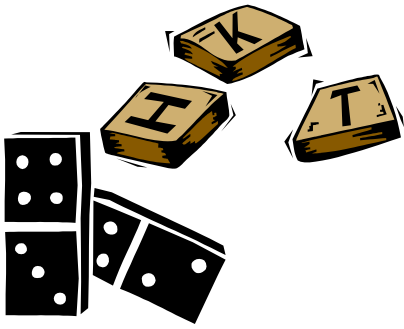

# **NAM**

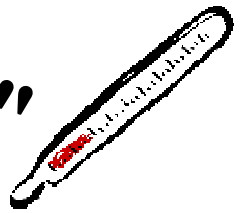

AUGUST 25<sup>TH</sup>



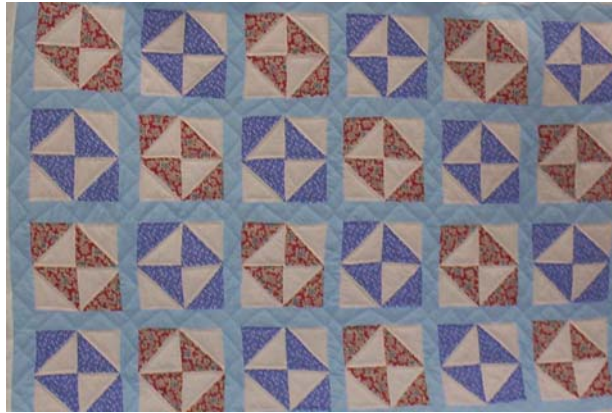
