Mmmm Good! Come by the front office and sign up before July 12th for a delicious root beer float for only a \$1.00. Open for 18 & up.



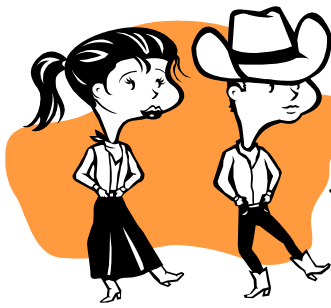
BINGO!

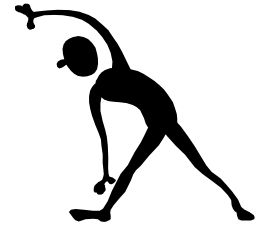


LINEDANCING

GIRL SCOUT TROOPS

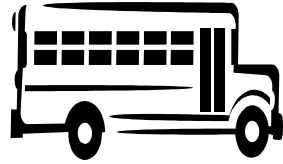
The Center has several different troops that meet here each month in the evening. If you have an interest in getting involved in one of these groups. Please contact the Center for more information.

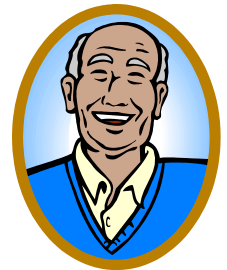

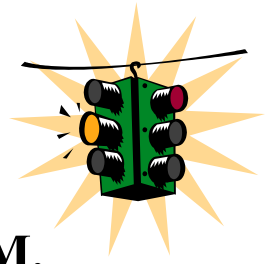
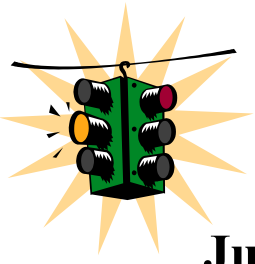
PCT. 4 TRIP—50 & UP JULY 8TH GULF GREYHOUND PARK

HURRICANE & TRACKING PRESENTATION

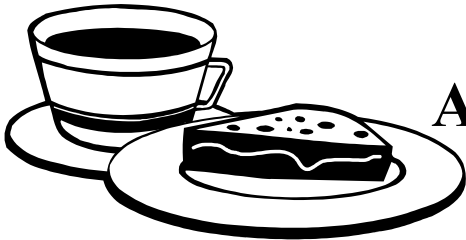
JULY 14TH @ 10A.M. – 11A.M.

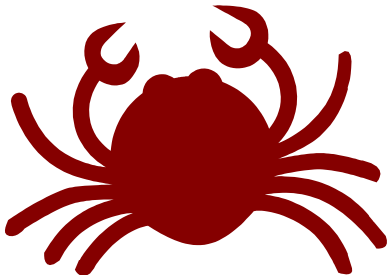

AGES 18 & UP

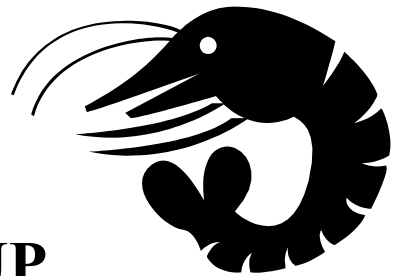

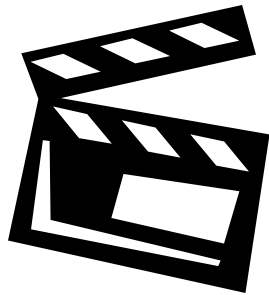

JULY 1ST HOLIDAY BASH

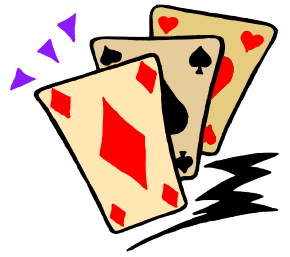

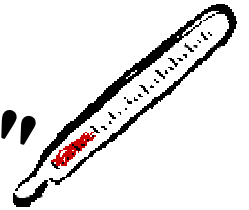

VOLUNTEERS

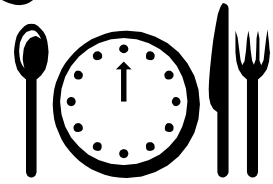

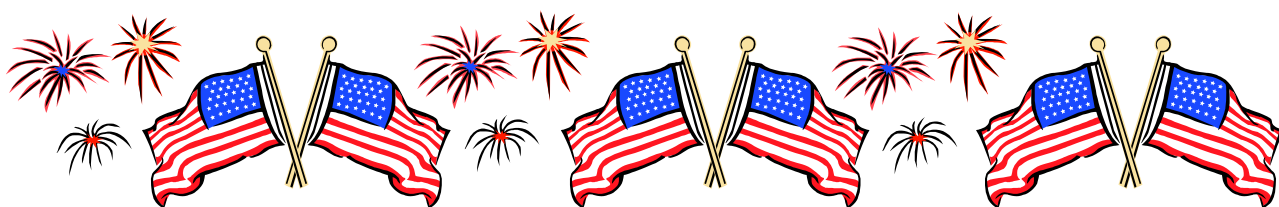
QUILTERS
