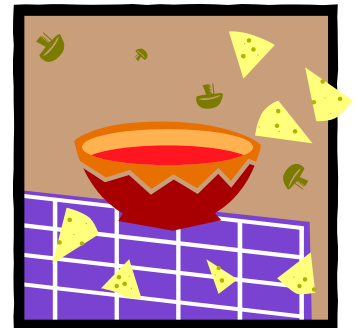

November 3rd



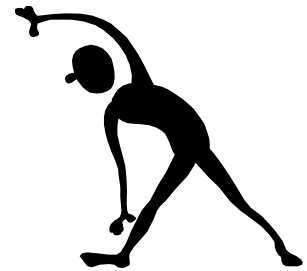
We will start playing bingo at 1 p.m. sharp for all ages that would like to join us for a hour of fun. Bring a friend and come on down.

NOVEMBER 8TH

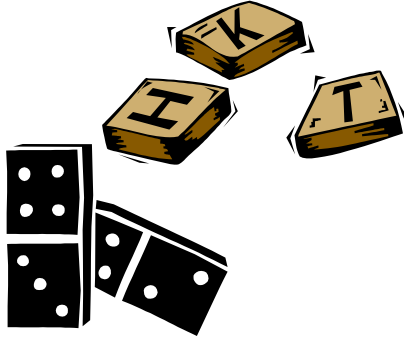
We will depart the Center @ 10:30 a.m. sharp. We will be eating at the Hickory Hollow in Magnolia. Reserve your seat before November 4th.

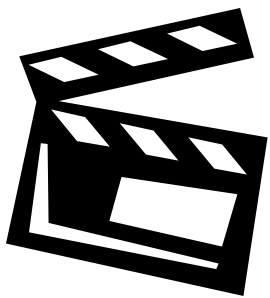

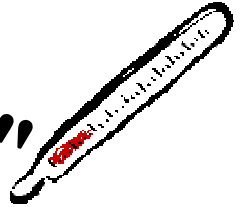

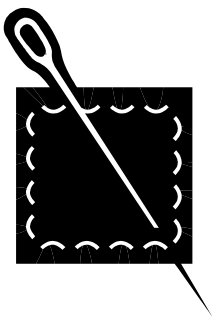
Not feeling "up to snuff?"

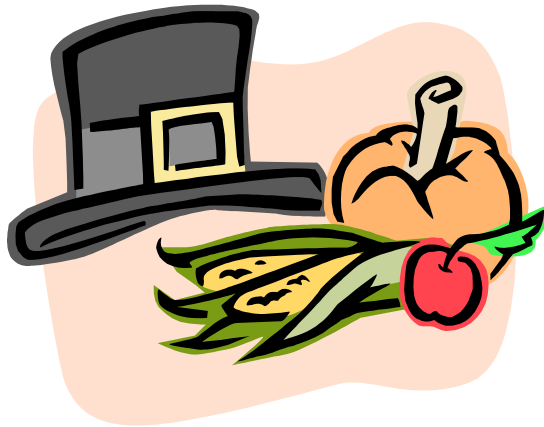


QUILTERS
