SEPTEMBER 1ST



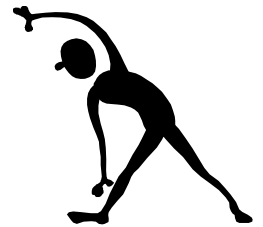
We will start playing bingo at 1 p.m. sharp for all ages that would like to join us for a hour of fun. Bring a friend and come on down.

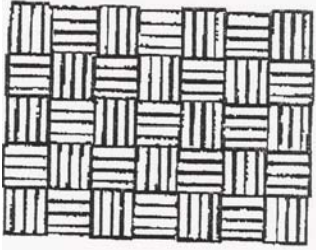

Be sure to pick up a supply list in the office. Swedish weaving is also know as Huck Embroidery. This needle art became popular in the late 1940's. Homemakers decorated the borders of Huck towels with embroidery floss. Today, crafters make couch throws, baby blankets, pillows, wall hangings,pictures, and table linens using yarn and monk's cloth. They also enjoy using a variety of threads on other even-weave fabrics, such as Huck cloth, Huck Toweling, and Aida cloth.

CROCHET CLASS

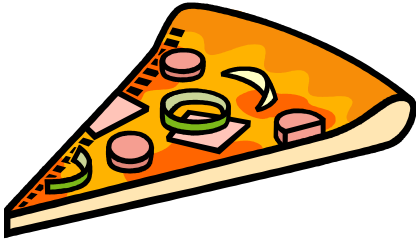
WEDNESDAYS – 10 - 11a.m.

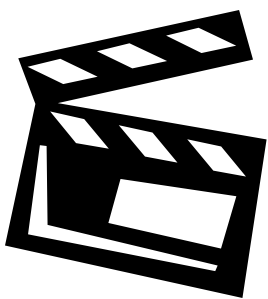

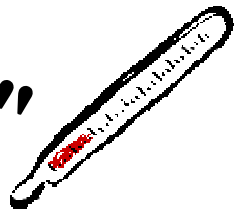
