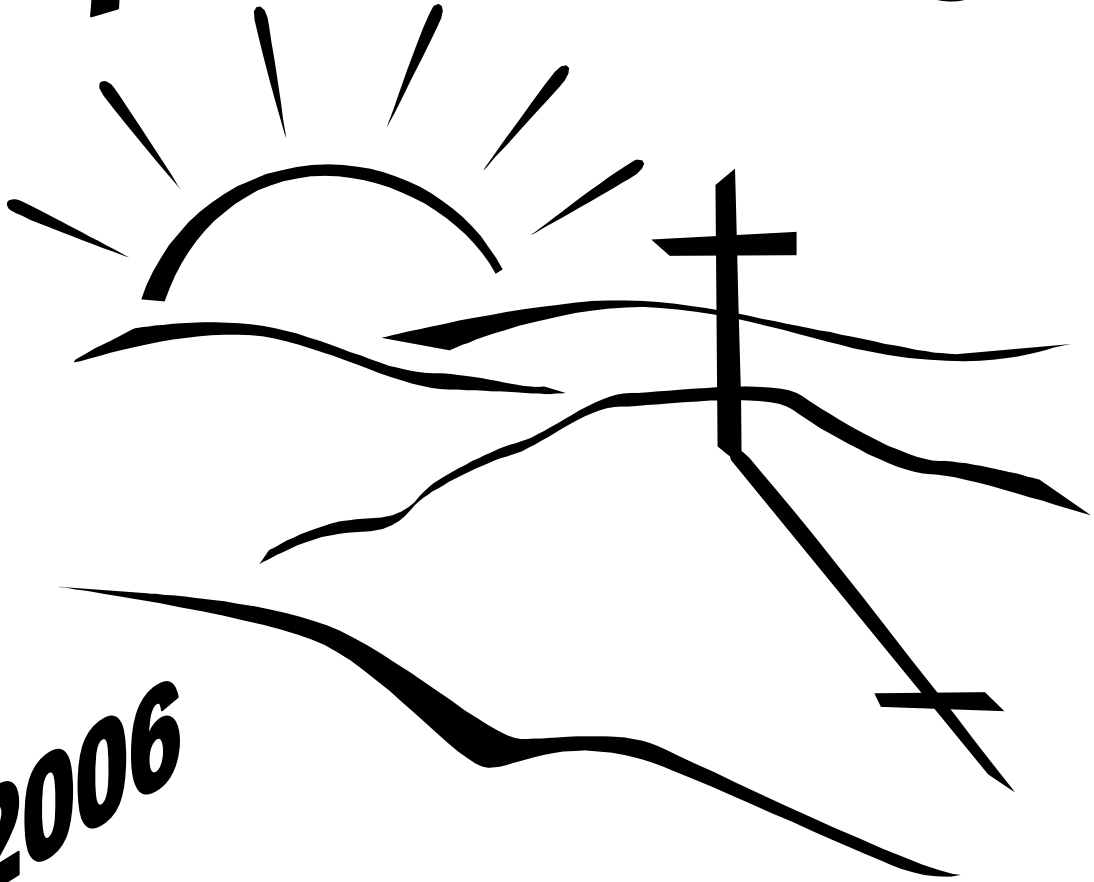

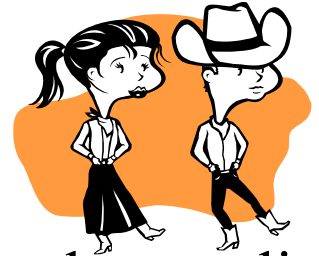

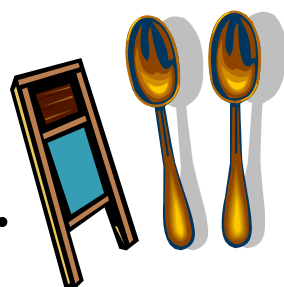

Requirements:

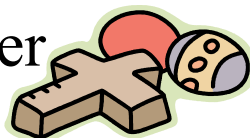
- 21 yrs or older

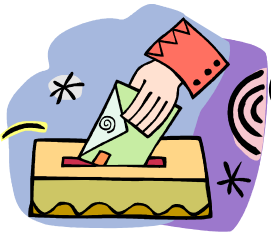
## PORCELAIN ART GUILD

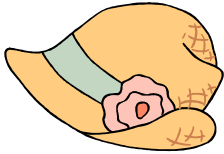

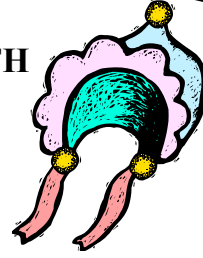

APRIL 1<sup>ST</sup> – 10<sup>TH</sup>



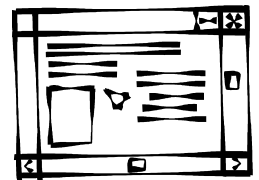

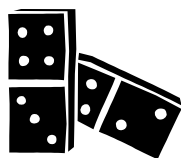
## Community Center Quilters



**Tuesdays & Fridays**

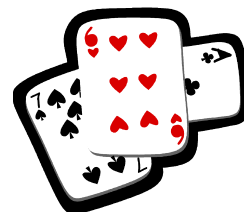
