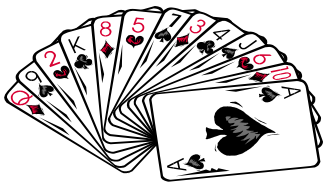


TOMBALL COIN CLUB
