50+ SINGLES GROUP

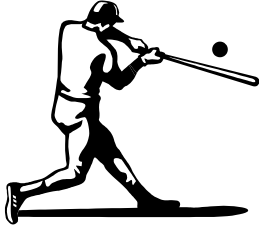

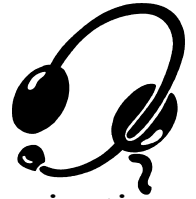


ASTROS
