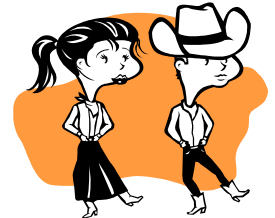

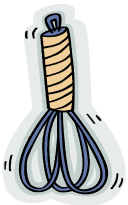

## 50+ SINGLES GROUP

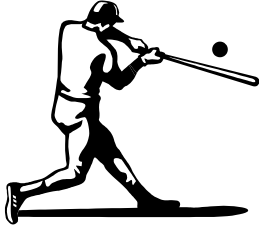

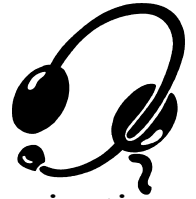


# ASTROS
