This class is an art of Japanese paper folding. Come and see you may just like it. It's fun to create art. The volunteer teaching is Jessica Bishea.

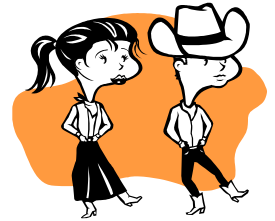

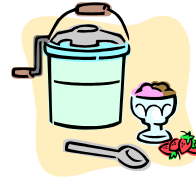
