We CANNOT Accept:

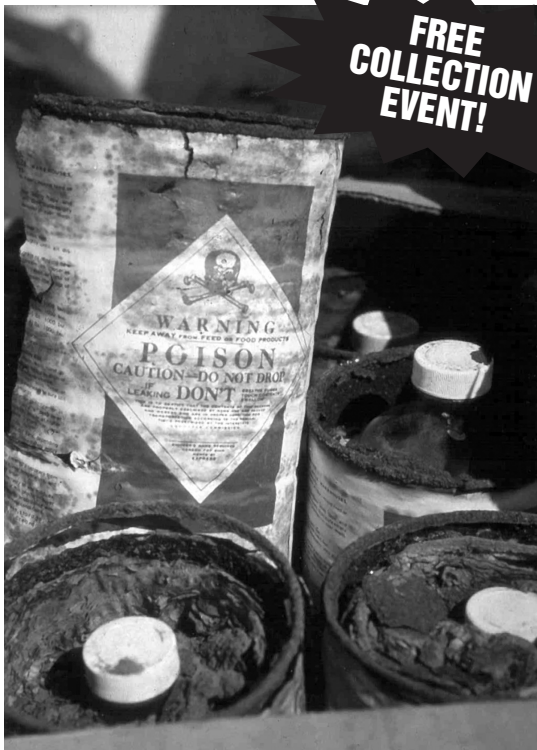
- Tires
