



IMMUNIZATIONS - Babies need shots at 2, 4, 6 and 12-15 months. Children need shots at 4-6 years and 11-14 years. All kids can catch up on their shots at any age. Adults need shots too! Need immunizations, we want to help you!

TEXAS IMMUNIZATION REGISTRY-ImmTrac - Never lose your child's shot record again. Let us enter it into the Texas Immunization Registry.

MEDICAL HOME - What is a Medical Home? A Medical Home is a doctor's office or clinic where you can take your children for: sick visits well visits shots

If you need assistance with locating a Medical Home, we are here to help you.

BIRTH CERTIFICATES - Since 1992, the Vital Statistics office, located at the City of Lubbock Health Department, has utilized "Remote Site Access" (provided by the Texas Department of Health Bureau of Vital Statistics) to assist the citizens of Lubbock County and citizens born within the State of Texas to receive their birth certificate. Identification is required to obtain a birth certificate. If you do not have a current driver's license, two of the following forms of identification are accepted:

- · Car insurance that has your name on it
- · Social Security card
- Expired Driver's License .
- · Utility bill that has your name on it
- Voter Registration Card (must be current)
- · Health Insurance card with your name on it
- · Marriage license

The fee for a birth certificate is \$23 per copy. For information, call 806-775-2926

FRIENDS OF THE LIBRARY

FOL is a non-profit organization that devotes time and effort to raising funds for the benefit of the Lubbock Public Libraries. Applications to join Friends of the Library can be picked up at any location or are located on the library's website. Memberships are \$10 and you must be 16 or older to become a volunteer to help sort books for the annual book sale. The Friends of the Library Book Sale will take place Nov. 6-8 in the Mahon Library basement. New memberships and renewals will also be available at the door during Book Sale days.

GENEALOGY

Mahon Library has an extensive genealogy and family history collection for those interested in researching their roots. Volunteers from the South Plains Genealogical Society maintain the collection and are available at scheduled hours on weekdays to assist you.

MATERIALS

The library has specialty items that are available to check out with your library card including DVDs, video games, and large print books. DVDs and games have a 3-day checkout period. Video games include Wii, Gamecube, XBOX360, XBOX, and PS2.

BRIDWELL TECHNOLOGY CENTER

At Mahon Library there are 17 computers in our technology center available for public use 7 days a week. It is open late until 8:30 PM Monday through Wednesday. Internet access and word processing are available on every machine. Microsoft Office (Word, Excel, Publisher & Powerpoint) is available on 10 computers. Printouts cost 10 cents per page. The Bridwell Technology Center is generously provided by Travis & Laney Bridwell, The Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation, and The City of Lubbock.

LIBRARY INTERNET COMPUTERS

Each of the libraries has a computer lab with access to the Internet. There is a 1-hour time limit, and you must have a library card to use the computer. Children under 18 must have a parent sign a permission form, in person, before they can use the Internet. Printouts cost 10 cents per page. Some of the computers have word processing, Microsoft Office, educational games, and other programs. The Groves Branch Library, 5520 19th Street, has free wireless Internet access. Library staff can get you started, but some basic knowledge of computers is necessary. Adult computer classes are offered for free at the Patterson Branch Library; call 767-3300 for more information.

WILDLIFE MITIGATION AREA 2009-2010 GAME HUNTING OPPORTUNITIES

Hunting is allowed at Lake Alan Henry under certain restrictions. Requirements include obtaining a State-issued Hunting License and appropriate stamps from the Texas Parks and Wildlife Department for 2009-2010 and a City-issued Permit for a fee. Hunters must sign a liability release and report all harvest information. Purchase of a permit does not guarantee the harvest of game. Hunting access is allowed only on Fridays, Saturdays and Sundays through the hunting season.

Permit fee paid by hunter is determined by hunter residency.
