NOTICE TO ELECTRICAL CONTRACTORS

In accordance with The City of Lubbock electrical code section 6-181, and the Texas Electrical Contractor Licensing Law 1305.166, vehicles directly used for purposes of electrical contracting shall display the contractor's name and the number of the <u>license</u> issued by the State of Texas executive director, e.g. TECL#.

Section 1305.166. Display of License (b)

- (1) Printed in letters and numbers that are at least two inches high and in a color that contrasts with the color of the background surface; and
- (2) Permanently affixed in conspicuous places on both sides of the vehicle.

The City of Lubbock Building Inspection department will begin issuing citations effective April 1, 2006 for failure to comply with this requirement.
