FINAL ORDER ESTABLISHING THE MOST EFFICIENT RATE OF PRODUCTION FOR THE PICA NO. 1 AND THE CLUBB WEST NO. 1 SOUR LAKE EASTER (YEGUA) FIELD HARDIN COUNTY, TEXAS

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on February 13, 2008, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is ordered by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the most efficient rate of production at the current time for the each well in the Sour Lake Easter (Yegua) Field is 450 BOPD. It is further ordered that the most efficient rate of production for the Cimarex Energy Co. - Clubb West (25144) No. 1 in the Sour Lake Easter (Yegua) Field is 680 BOPD. It is further ordered that all overproduction in the Sour Lake Easter (Yegua) Field is hereby canceled.
