## FINAL ORDER RESCINDING THE MER IN THE PLEASANT GROVE FIELD RUSK COUNTY, TEXAS

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on June 2, 2008, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, hereby adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is ordered by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the MER of 40 BOPD per well in the Pleasant Grove Field, Rusk County, Texas, is hereby rescinded. The top allowable in the field shall be 93 BOPD, based on the 1947 Yardstick. It is further ordered that all overproduction in the Pleasant Grove Field is hereby canceled.
