FINAL ORDER ESTABLISHING THE MOST EFFICIENT RATE OF PRODUCTION FOR THE JOHN P. RYAN TRUSTEE WELL NO. 1 EMERALD (SILURIAN) FIELD YOAKUM COUNTY, TEXAS

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on September 18, 2007, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.
