**FINAL ORDER  
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF CONOCO, INC.  
TO ESTABLISH AN MER AND INCREASED GOR AUTHORITY  
FOR THE RINCON (80 VICKSBURG) FIELD  
STARR COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on October 18, 2000, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the application of Conoco, Inc. is granted such that each well in the Rincon (80 Vicksburg) Field, Starr County, Texas, be and is hereby allowed to produce up to 1000 barrels of oil per day and to produce under increased gas-oil ratio authority, with a daily gas limit of 3500 MCF.

It is further **ORDERED** that all overproduction for the Conoco, Inc., T.B. Slick A-527 Lease in the Rincon (80 Vicksburg) Field, Starr County, be and is hereby canceled.
