The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on May 24, 2001, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

Cocke lease (12988) is hereby canceled.
