FINAL ORDER ESTABLISHING THE MOST EFFICIENT RATE OF PRODUCTION FOR THE TRIUMPH EXPLORATION, IC. JED CLAMPETT AND JED CLAMPETT "A" LEASES, MEANS FIELD, ANDREWS COUNTY, TEXAS

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on June 21, 2000, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which was service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

Therefore, it is ordered by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the most efficient rate of production for well(s) completed on the Triumph Exploration, Inc., Jed Clampett Lease and Jed Clampett "A" Lease in the Means Field, Andrews County, Texas, is established at 190 barrels of oil per day per well.

It is further ordered that all overproduction for the subject wells on the Jed Clampett and Jed Clampett "A" Leases is hereby canceled.
