**FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF HUNT OIL COMPANY
TO ESTABLISH AN MER
FOR ITS J.M. WHITE LEASE WELL NO. 5
MEANS FIELD
ANDREWS COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on March 1, 2001, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the application of Hunt Oil Company is granted such that its J.M. White Lease Well No. 5 in the Means Field, Andrews County, Texas, be and is hereby allowed to produce up to 435 barrels of oil per day.

It is further **ORDERED** that all overproduction for the Hunt Oil Company J.M. White Lease Well No. 5 in the Means Field, Andrews County, be and is hereby canceled.
