**FINAL ORDER
APPROVING THE APPLICATION OF CITATION OIL & GAS COMPANY
FOR INCREASED GAS/OIL RATIO AUTHORITY, AND
MER DETERMINATION
ABELL (DETRITAL) FIELD
CRANE COUNTY, TEXAS**

The Commission finds that after statutory notice in the above-numbered docket heard on April 19, 2001, the presiding examiner has made and filed a report and recommendation containing findings of fact and conclusions of law, for which service was not required; that the proposed application is in compliance with all statutory requirements; and that this proceeding was duly submitted to the Railroad Commission of Texas at conference held in its offices in Austin, Texas.

The Commission, after review and due consideration of the examiner's report and recommendation, the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, adopts as its own the findings of fact and conclusions of law contained therein, and incorporates said findings of fact and conclusions of law as if fully set out and separately stated herein.

Therefore, it is **ORDERED** by the Railroad Commission of Texas that the application of Citation Oil & Gas Company be and is hereby granted to allow wells in the Abell (Detrital) Field, Crane County, Texas, to produce under increased gas-oil ratio authority with a daily gas limit of 1000 MCF; and to allow wells to produce 500 barrels of oil per day, the most efficient rate of production at the current time for the Abell (Detrital) Field, Crane County, Texas.

It is further **ORDERED** that all overproduction for wells in the Abell (Detrital) Field be canceled.
